raining at 10 A. M. double reefed Topsails.

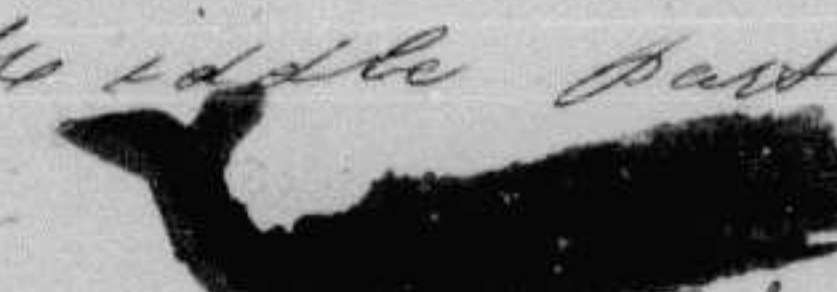
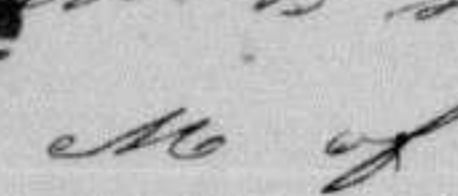
Tuesday 5th These 24 hours commence
