altering Main Top Sail Latt 0.13.1

on her passage to the Coast in Aug.
Saturday 11th Still strong breezes from the
S heading E S E employed in altering Main
Top Sail Latter part pleasant
Latt 0.19.8

Sunday 12th These 24 hours light winds from
the S heading E S E & employed in bending
Main Top Sail & altering & bending Top
S E Sail Latter part made sail
Latt 03.5

Monday 13th These 24 hours commence with
light airs & pleasant at 7th M spoke
Ship President Latter part broke out
for Bar also saw humpbacks Latt 0.14.8

Tuesday 14th These 24 hours strong breezes
from the S heading E S E spoke ships
May & President Latter part squally

Wednesday 15th Still strong breezes from
the S heading E S E & employed in
setting a cloth into B. P. Sail at 4th P M
double reefed the Top Sails & took in the
Main Sail Latter part made all
sail & tacked to the E Latt 1.25

Thursday 16th These 24 hours commence
with light winds from the S heading E S E
& employed in bending B. P. Sail also
spoke Barque Lafayette & passed ship
May & broke out for water Latter
part employed in setting a cloth into
Main Top Sail also wore ship to
the S E Latt 1.45
