 Tuesday 28th These 24 hours commence with moderate breeze from the S^W to S employed in breaking out for shooks at 6^h AM double reefed the Top Sails. Middle part wore to the S^W & W. Latter part made sail & tacked to the S^E Lat 23⁵

Wednesday 29th These 24 hours commence with light winds from the S^W heading S^E & employed in setting up shooks. Latter part pleasant

Thursday 30th At 1¹/₂ P^M anchored in Bombay. Latter part employed in getting off water

Friday Employed in stowing down water. Barque Birchwood laying off & on. Latter part got off a raft of water suited Barque. Crew Fisher

Saturday Employed in stowing down water. Latter part stowing down

Sunday Employed in getting off water. Latter part all hands ashore

Monday & Tuesday stowing down water & painting ship

Wednesday arrived ship Paul of Bedford

Thursday arrived ship Mass. Harris of Nantucket 200⁰ Latter part

Laying in Bombay in Sept. arrived ship Catawba

Friday employed in getting off potatoes

Saturday arrived ship Courier of Bedford

Sunday 11th Arrived ship Lydia of Fair Haven

Thursday 13th Arrived Barque Lafay & sailed ship Nauticon bound to Porto. Latter part employed in stowing chains

Friday 14th These 24 hours light air & pleasant weather spoke ship Empire. Latter part pleasant

Saturday 15th These 24 hours light winds from the S^W to heading S^E at 5^h AM double reefed the Top Sails. Latter part made sail & tacked to the S^E Lat 3.5²

Sunday 16th These 24 hours commence with strong breezes from the S^W at 5^h AM double reefed the Top Sails & wore to the S^W. Latter part made sail & tacked to the S^E Lat 4.2⁸
