

Remarks on board ship Nauticon
Thursday 27th At 7 P.M. shortened sail
Continued still in sight of the volcano
Wind S S E Latter part made sail & tacked
to the S W

Friday 28th These 24 hours commence with
light winds from the S S E at 3
Wind S S E & M tacked to the S E at 8 to
the S W & again at 2 A.M.
to the S Latter part broke out
for water & sent up new Mgn. R. yard

Saturday 29th These 24 hours light winds &
pleasant weather signaled with
Wind S S E ship Constitution & sent up new
Mgn. R. yard at 4 P.M. tacked to
the S W Latter part painted
the S Boat & spoke ship Napoleon
28 men 1000 sperm

Sunday 30th These 24 hours moderate winds
Wind S & pleasant weather in company
with the Napoleon Latter part
hazy

Monday Oct 1st These 24 hours strong breezes
Wind S & hazy spoke ships Napoleon
& Constitution Latter part
sent a boat in fishing at
N E end

Tuesday 2nd These 24 hours moderate
Wind S breezes & pleasant weather
Course W S W at 6 P.M. double reefed
the Cap. Sails also started
L att 2.17 S a cask of water Latter
part pleasant

Bound to the Off Shore Ground
Wednesday 3rd These 24 hours commence with
Wind S S E strong breezes & pleasant weather
heading S W Latter part made all sail &
tared the Topsail Wheels

Thursday 4th These 24 hours commence with
Wind S E light winds & pleasant weather
Course S by E Latter part light airs put out
L att. 2.55 S S. Boat & took in the S. Boat

Friday 5th These 24 hours commence with
Wind S E light airs & pleasant weather
Course S by E started a cask of water
L att 1.29 Latter part painted L Boat
Long 98.12

Saturday 6th These 24 hours light winds &
Wind S E pleasant weather employed in
Course S by E painting L Boat Latter part
lowered for whales chase till
12 A.M. then came on board
& at 1 P.M. of Sunday 7th

Sunday 7th lowered again & chased till 6
then came on board & took
Wind S E in sail & lay a back
L att 2.15 Latter part made sail and
steered to N W

Monday 8th Moderate breezes & pleasant
Weather at 3 P.M. spoke
Wind S E ship Osello of Charleston
heading S W 15 days from Rio de
L att 2.32 Janeiro bound to California
with 39 passengers Latter
part broke out for
M cat & tacked to the
S S W Middle
part wore to the
S S E
