 & M wore to the NE & at 6 p.m. to
 Wind N the W. Latter part strong winds
 Latt 14.48 employed in setting up R. P. M.
 Backstays

Tuesday 27th
 These 24 hours strong winds & cloudy at 1 p.m.
 & M made sail & steered S with the wind
 N at 5 p.m. luffed to the SW three small
 Is in sight at 6 double reefed the Topsails
 took in Jib & courses Middle part squally
 Latter part took in B. & M. N. Topsails &
 broke out for Ethur & wore to the E. & N.E.

Wednesday 28th
 At 2 p.m. set B. & M. N. Topsails at 5 p.m.
 & M took them in & wore ship to the W. N.
 to Latter part set whole Topsails & Jib and
 wore ship to the E. & N.E. & made an Island bearing
 N distant 15 miles Latt 15.53

 took in sail & wore to the W. N. to Latter part
 set the M. sail & Jib Latt 16.00

Friday 30th
 Light winds from the NE steering to NW
 at 5 p.m. luffed to the N. N. to at 5 p.m. took in
 M. sail & lay aback Latter part made Deans
 Is bearing N. by E distant 15 miles Latt 15.24
