Monday 3<sup>rd</sup>

Light winds from the E.S.E. heading N.E.  
with pleasant weather Latter part double  
reefed the Topsails took in the M. air sail

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup>

Strong breezes & pleasant at 2 PM wore for  
without success Latter part employed  
in setting up rigging Latter 11.00

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> Long 147-49

Strong winds from the E with pleasant weather  
at 6 PM wore to the N.N.E. Latter part  
lowered for without success

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup>

Strong breezes & squally at 8 PM lowered for  
to be struck & at 6 took him  
along side took in the M. & M. J. sails Jib  
& courses & lay by him till morning then  
cut him in

Friday 7<sup>th</sup> Strong winds employed  
in boiling Latter 13.05

Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> employed in  
boiling at 8 AM lowered for Latter 13.15

Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> squally Latter 13.28

Monday 9<sup>th</sup> Finished boiling &  
washed off

Monday 9<sup>th</sup> Latter part set the Mizzen  
Top sail & Jib Latter 13.23

Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup>

Strong breezes from the N.E. heading E.S.E.  
& squally at 6 PM took in the Jib Latter  
part light airs wore ship to the N.N.E. and  
made all sail & cooped & stowed down at 11  
AM took in the J. S. Sails

Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> Light airs from the E heading

N.N.E. employed in washing  
Latter 12.27 ship at 6 PM took in the Main  
sail Middle part double reefed  
the J. S. Sails Latter part squally

Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> Squally with rain broke out  
Wind N.N.E. for meat Latter part took in  
Heading E Mizzen Topsails  
Latter 13.30

Friday 14<sup>th</sup> Strong winds & squally at 5 PM  
Wind N.N.E. wore to the N.W. Latter part  
Latter 13.46 wore to the E

Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> Laying to heading E at 8 PM  
Wind N.N.E. wore to the N.W.  
Latter 13.51 Latter part set the Mizzen  
Long 147.10 Top sails Jib & M. air sail

Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> Strong winds & squally heading  
to the S.E. & employed in  
Latter 13.18  
Long 147.07  
breaking out for Butter at 7 PM  
Wore to the N.N.W.  
Latter part made all sail

Monday 17<sup>th</sup> Light airs & pleasant  
at 1 PM wore to the S.E.  
Latter part pleasant wore  
to the N.N.E.

Hard times and worse coming  
Latter 13.28
