Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> Strong winds & squally at 5 P.M.  
Latt 13.57 wore two under double reefed M  
Sail & F. Sail Latter part  
moderate made sail & wore to the E  
at 11 A.M. lowered for whales  
and chased till 6 P.M. of

Friday 28<sup>th</sup> when the L boat struck & droued

Latt 14.04 part squally with rain
