

Remarks on board ship *Nauticon* in Jan.

Friday 4th Light winds & cloudy latter part strong breezes & squally wore to Wind N.E. the E & double reefed the Top sails took in Jib spanker & Main sail

Saturday 5th strong breezes & squally employed Wind N.E. in heading out for Bread & Meat at 7³⁰ M took in Fore & Main Top sails & wore to the N.E. Latter part made sail & wore to the E

Sunday 6th strong winds & squally passed a Wind N.E. French Barque steering to the S.W. Latt 13.48 at 7³⁰ M wore to the N.E. Latter part wore to E.S.E.

Monday 7th Strong winds & squally at 8³⁰ M Wind N.E. wore to the N.E. Latter Latt 12.42 part made all sail & tacked to S.W.

Tuesday 8th Light winds & pleasant weather X Wind N.E. standing to the S.E. Latter part Latt 13.46 pleasant this day opened a ball Long 147.51 of Britain

Wednesday 9th Light winds & pleasant weather at 6³⁰ M tacked to Wind N.E. the N.E. Middle part wore to the E Latter part double reefed the Top sails

Thursday 10th strong winds & squally Latt Wind N. part pleasant made all sail Latt 13.42 & tacked to the N.E.

Friday 11th Light winds & pleasant weather Wind E.N.E. Latter part broke out for water Latt 13.11 Long 147.43 & tacked to the S.E.

15 months out living on bread & water Saturday 12th Light winds & pleasant weather Wind E.N.E. employed in getting darts for a shot Latt 13.44 Row Boat middle part wore to the S. Long 147.17 Latt part squally double reefed the Topsails & wore to the S.E.

Sunday 13th strong winds & squally weather Wind E.N.E. Latter part pleasant made all Latt 14.34 sail standing to the S.E.

Monday 14th Light winds & pleasant Wind E.S.E. weather standing to the N.E. at 4³⁰ M made an S. bearing E 12 miles distant Middle part squally double reefed the Top sails Latter part laying off & on at Peacock

Tuesday 15th strong breezes laying off & on high Wind E & Latter parts working up to turtles also broke out for Meat

Wednesday 16th Light airs laying off & on at Wilsons Is. Latter part band 3rd distant 6 miles lowered for Whales L.B. struck & at 2³⁰ M of

Thursday 17th took him along side & cut in Wind E Latter part boiling

Friday 18th finished boiling Latter part Wind E pleasant minded N.E. S. Latt

Saturday 19th Laying off & on at Peacock Is. Latter part lowered for Whales L.B. & got it at 4³⁰ M of Sunday 20th cut one in at 4.4 M one side adrift from a long side at 7 took him along side again & cut in

Monday 21st boiling
