

Tuesday the 3rd Feb 1835.

Commenced with light breezes from N.W. heading to the North. Middle part wind hauled to the N. & N.W. Exchanged light & C at 12. Saw 8 sperm whales. Took a to the ship. Also with an English barque spoke a French ship from Curacoa arrived Caliper ago
Sun Obscured

Wednesday the 4th Feb

These 24 hours South winds steering N.W. 3 ships in sight. Ends with a Glorious wind. Lon by Chronometer 74° 33' 30" West
Lat by Obs 55° 59' South

Thursday the 5th Feb

A Glorious South wind steering N.W. By 2. Lost the West boat off the Enanes at 11. came up with and spoke ship *Wm & Henry* of from Salem around Conception
Lon by Chro 74° 04' 30". Lat by Obs 53° 47' S

Friday the 6th Feb.

First fine breezes. Middle and latter parts light airs and calm. Hoarded ship. *Wm & Henry* 44 days out
Lat by Obs 51° 34' S

Saturday the 7th Feb

This day first and middle going N.W. Latter part N.W. wind heading N.E. thick at 6 took to the West
Lat 50° 00' South

Sunday the 8th Feb

This day wind variable from N. to N.W. working to the Northward. Latter strong gails with squalls doubled reefed the topsails
Lon by Chro 77° 32' 30"
Lat by Obs 49° 31' S

Monday the 9th Feb 1835.

First and middle fresh N.W. winds steering to the North. Latter N.W. wind heading to the North. Saw 8 sperm whales. Took a to the ship. Lon 77° 03' 30". Lat 46° 45' South

Tuesday the 10th Feb

This day fresh breezes with rain took in weather. whales commenced boiling. Ends with rain
Lat by Obs 47° 06' South

Wednesday the 11th Feb

This day variable from a Gale to calm with rain blow or not continual rain a boiling. Lost the West boat off the Enanes at 11. Sun Obscured

Thursday the 12th Feb

Thick with rain squalls at 4 & 8 finished boiling. Ends rugged weather

Friday the 13th Feb

This day better weather. Saw porpoises & black fish. Lon by Chronometer 75° 51' 15" West.
Lat by Obs 46° 22' South

Saturday the 14th Feb

Fresh variable winds from N. to N.W. working N. with rain squalls. Lat by Obs 45° 36' South

Sunday the 15th Feb

These 24 hours commenced with wind N heading N.W. Middle heading to the N.W. and N.E. wind N.W. and West
Lon by Obs 74° 40' 30" W.
Lat by Obs 43° 52' S
