Sent on Shore 316 Gale Sperm Oil.

Tuesday the 24th March

Tilting the boats the ship embarked
Ends In Callao.

Wednesday the 25th March

at 9 A.M. took our anchor ran out of
Callao bay on bent the chains &c in company
my with ship Lancaster

Thursday the 26th March

Fine breeze standing off phone in company
with ship Lancaster Ends Lat 12° 14' S

Friday the 27th March

Fine weather bent a main top G. Hail
repairing sails Lat 13° 04' S

Saturday the 28th March 1835

This day fine weather at 4 P.M. Leaned
the boats took 6 blackfish to the ship
Ends

Sunday the 29th March

This day fine weather at 3 P.M. whale
put off took one to the ship Lancaster
in company No 3

Monday the 30th March

Finished boiling Lancaster in company
Lat 13° 04' S 9° 10' S

Tuesday the 31st March

Fine weather round round for another
whale Lat 13° 04' S 10° 00' S

Wednesday the 1st April

Steering W N W. & N N W. engaged in
repairing sails Lat 13° 04' S 6° 38' S

Thursday the 2nd April

Fine weather engaged in repairing
sails in company with ship Lancaster
Lat 13° 04' S 5° 11' S

Friday the 3rd April

Fine breeze at 10 A.M. Lancaster set her
booms for whales at 12 Saw whales & one
the boats took one to the ship took
her in No 4 15 D. Lat 13° 04' S 4° 34' S

Saturday the 4th April

Light airs and calm boiled out the
whale Lancaster in company a boiling
