

Thursday the 30th April 1835.
These 24 hours fine breezes steering N by E.
Saw nothing of the whale kind saw a
few birds. Had a letter of 21st of 9.
Lat 12° 33' 33" South

Friday the 1st May 1835
These 24 hours fine weather steering
N by E. Saw a ship to the S. and
leading to the North. Saw many porpoises
- es. a large school of blackfish
Long by Chr Lat 12° 57' 57" S
Long by Chr Lat 121° 07' 07" West.

Saturday the 2nd May
These 24 hours fine breezes steering to the North
and West. Saw several schools of porpoises
Long by Chr Lat 122° 07' 15" West.
Lat 12° 29' 29" South

Sunday the 3rd May
These 24 hours fine breezes from the East
steering to the West. Saw porpoises
Long by Chr Lat 123° 12' 30" West.
Lat 12° 17' 17" South.

Monday the 4th May 1835.
This day saw a fine porpoise and various
sly engaged. Lat 12° 35' 35" South

Tuesday the 5th May
This day light breezes. Saw nothing
Long by Chr Lat 125° 40' 40" W. Lat 12° 00' 00" S

Wednesday the 6th May
This day saw 2 finbacks and several
finbacks.
Lat 12° 00' 00" S

Thursday the 7th May 1835.
This day put off the boats at 11 A.M.
for sperm whales. Struck at sunset
took the second whale to the ship.
Missed 2 more. Lat 12° 00' 00" S
Long by Chr from 125° 19' 45" W

Friday the 8th May
These 24 hours fine weather took the whales on
board commenced boiling more ship to the
S. by E. Saw many porpoises. Ends
Lat 12° 00' 19" North

Saturday the 9th May
This day leading to the S. by E. and N by E at
12 left off West for compass. Saw a finback
and porpoise. Lat 12° 00' 00" South

Sunday the 10th May
This day fine weather steering West
at 12 left off. Saw small fish and
porpoises begins to look encouraging
and why I cannot tell but so it is.
Lat 12° 00' 13" North

Monday the 11th May 1835.
Eight breezes with fine pleasant weather
steering N by E. Saw many schools of porpoises
one piece of squid a strong current
setting to the Eastward. Repaired fore
and main topmasts and otherwise engaged.
Long by Chr 127° 55' 15" W. Lat 12° 00' 12" South

Tuesday the 12th May
These 24 hours fine breezes steering N by E.
Saw 11 sharks and porpoises, a strong current
setting E. N. E., all variously engaged.
Long by Chr 129° 45' 45" W. Lat 12° 00' 04" S
