Short of a compliment of men went to Sea
Ship's Envoys in Tahiti

Pleasant & boats to old Jim's place for
logs took on board & boat load of moss
one of oranges &c in Tahiti

Tuesday the 22nd June
Shipped one Land took on board potatoes &c
finished our recruit took the 2 anchor
on the 13th one

Wednesday the 23rd June
Took our anchor towed out with the
Land wind went in with 2 boats Shipped
& Lands at 4 all on board Steaming Steady
Left 8 men on shore all deserted except
Tahitian Boy Ends fine breezes

Thursday the 24th June
These 24 hours strong breezes steering
to the north saw porpoises and birds
Ends this day
Lat By Obs 16⁰⁰ S.

Friday the 25th June
This day fresh Easterly breezes steering
to the north saw gumpers birds &c
Ends strong breezes with rain &c
Lat By Obs 14⁴⁶ S.

Saturday the 26th June
Fresh breezes with squalls saw nothing
of the Whale kind

Lat By Obs 12⁵⁷ S.

Saturday the 27th June 1835

These 24 hours fine breezes from the E
Steering to the north saw many birds
Ends with some squalls of rain
Low By Chron 150²⁰ West.

These 24 hours fine breezes steering to the
North at 2 P.M. saw Caroline Is bearing
W. 1/2 N. 15 miles passed it Ends all

Monday the 29th June
These 24 hours commenced and continues
with fine breezes with nothing in
sight Low By Obs 150⁵⁴ 45 West
Chron 151¹⁷ S. Lat By Obs 9⁰⁷ S.

Tuesday the 30th June
These days fine pleasant weather
with a beautiful breeze from E by N
Steering N by W
Lat By Obs 7³⁸ S.

Wednesday the 1st July
This day fine weather saw nothing
but shall soon I hope thou bright
Continuing Hope
Lat By Obs 5²⁷ South

Thursday the 2nd July 1835.
These 24 hours fine breezes steering
N N W. & West for Maldons Is saw
nothing of the Whale kind bent an other
rain to go to sail. Shifted the fore topsails
Low By Chron 152⁵⁵ 30 West
By Obs 152⁴² 45. Lat By Obs 4¹⁴ S.
