

Friday the 9th Oct 1835.

These 24 hours first clear repaired a Merganser topail and bent it at 1 A.M. Saw Rotuma leaving E.D.C. 25 or 30 miles passed under the lee of it. Saw many fish of the small kind repairing rotten water cask. Ends squally again for a variety.

Lat 15° 33' South Long 176° 35' East

Saturday the 10th Oct. These 24 hours fine weather wind from East. to S.E. leading to the Southward. Saw many small fish. Repairing rotten water cask. brook out and cleaned out the blubber room. repaired foretopmast staysail. Ends

Lat 15° 35' South Long 176° 35' East

Sunday the 11th Oct. These 24 hours fine breezes from the East leading to the S.E. at 3 P.M. Saw a large whale going quick to the S.E. and the boats could not come up with him. Saw By Chron 175° 5' 30" at 8 A.M.

Lat 15° 10' South Long 176° 30' East

Monday the 12th Oct. These 24 hours fine weather wind N.W. at 12 noon saw a large whale boat at 3 P.M. took him to the ship's hook and cut off the head. Lashed down. Saw By Chron 176° 30' at 11 A.M.

Lat 15° 46' South Long 176° 30' East

Tuesday the 13th Oct. Cut the whales in commenced boiling wind from N.W. to N.E. Saw much drift stuff. Lat 15° 53' South Long 176° 30' East

Wednesday the 14th Oct. Light variable wind finished boiling. Lat 15° 59' South Long 176° 30' East

Thursday the 15th Oct 1835.

These 24 hours light variable winds from S.W. to East. Steering West N.W. Saw many birds small fish. Drift wood &c. Ends this day. Saw By Chron 177° 34' East. Lat 15° 27' South Long 176° 30' East

Friday the 16th Oct

This day fine breezes from S.E. steering to the Westward. Saw breaches ran up with them could not see them again engaged in coping oil cask. Ends.

Saw By Chron 176° 34' 30" East at 8 A.M.

Lat 15° 17' South Long 176° 30' East

Saturday the 17th Oct.

These 24 hours fine breezes ran off 12 hours N.W. for Enaseusa but cannot find it it is not here. Saw Cowfish brook out the fore hole. Load 50 lbs oil washed off. Ends. Saw many birds.

Lat 15° 15' South Long 176° 30' East

Sunday the 18th Oct. This day fresh breezes from E.D.C. leading to the S.E. 12 hours N.W. a bad swell from the South. Ends with heavy weather. Saw porpoises and birds. Saw By Chron 174° 04' 15" East.

Lat 16° 08' South Long 174° 04' 15" East

Monday the 19th Oct. This day fresh E.D.C. breezes leading to the South. 12 hours N.W. with heavy weather a bad sea from South. Saw much drift wood birds &c. repaired and bent a main top sail and top of sail.

Lat 17° 14' South Long 173° 44' East

Tuesday the 20th Oct. This day fresh breezes from E.D.C. and E.S.E. leading to the South. repairing sails at 12 Calms a bad swell. Saw By Chron 173° 44' East.

Lat 18° 16' South Long 173° 44' East
