Fine weather arrived the Ship Blarriet from Japan Coast. 12 m 400 lbs Oil getting off now in rags.

Sunday the 29th Nov^r

Fine weather all hands went to church in sacros

Monday the 30th Nov

Fine weather Getting off water & wood and
showing it away Ends 1

Tuesday the 1st Dec 1835

Took 100 lbs water on board one boat crew & cutting wood Bent up top of 2 yams.

Wednesday the 2nd Dec

Sailing mwd. & heat loads of coconuts.

Thursday the 3rd Dec

Fine breezes with pleasant taking off mood and water whiped to canaches. Encls in vessels.

Friday the 1st Dec

Fine weather sent in the Jitt boom hooped the
cups filled the riggin &c. The natives brought
off our run away Gentlemen Quack put them in
crows for safe keeping & nas.

Saturday the 5th Dec

Five Easterly breezes with pleasant weather took our
sloop ran out hauled to the V.C. at 7 & M Saw
a low sand isl bearing NW. Dis 10 miles off and
on to the Mindanao through the night.

Sunday the 6th Dec

Strong bouzges leading to the N.E. Pingle nups
with over east saw nothing
No Ob this day

Monday the 7th Dec

Thick with rain at 9 ticks H₂O under double
reefs thick, rising with a red sea
Sun obscured.

Tuesday the 15th Dec

Rain in abundance. Leading out P.C. and H.P.C.
Saw many small fish a' bed. Sea with
fresh winds. Sun Observed.

Wednesday the 9th Dec

Kind N.B. Leading to the Eastward rain under
double reefs Sun obscured

Thursday the 10th Dec

Wind variable working to the S. and E. with sea
weather and continual rain
Sun Obscured.
