

Thursday the 26th Dec 1835.

Fresh breezes with squalls at 4 P.M. finished boiling wash off put the tackle up for breaking out the hold. Lat 15° 05' N Long 27° 11' W

Wednesday the 25th Dec
 Engaged in breaking out and hauling in oil in the fore hold. Saw porpoises & pieces of squid birds in abundance. Lat 15° 05' N Long 27° 11' W

Thursday the 26th Dec
 Finished stowing in the fore hold. Broke out the main hatchway. Cleared up the between decks. No coals this day.

Friday the 27th Dec
 This day fresh breezes & fresh the ship's water of London 13 M. 600 lbs oil saw many birds finished stowing 187 lbs oil. passed a ship to the windward. Lat 15° 05' N Long 26° 45' W

Saturday the 28th Dec
 These 24 hours variable weather a looking land for a whale. Lat 15° 05' N Long 26° 15' W

Sunday the 29th Dec
 This day fine weather turned up at 4 P.M. Looked boats nailed & painted them. Put bent an other jibs. Put up 6 hooks for that whale. Lat 15° 05' N Long 27° 00' W

Monday the 30th Dec
 These 24 hours fresh winds heading to the N.E. wind E.N.E. overcast. at 12 Meridian more to the N.E. and N.W. Saw many birds & fish the watch variously engaged. Lat 15° 05' N Long 28° 03' W

Thursday the 31st Dec

These 24 hours commenced with fresh breezes from the N.E. leading to the N.W. Latter come up North. Saw a jumper passed a ship to the Westward. Saw many birds repaired main & fore masts. Sticked a jib. Ends. Lat 15° 05' N Long 27° 04' W

Friday the 1st January 1836
 This day fine weather at 6 A.M. Saw whales put off. Sailed all day could not strike. Saw the Cadmus like a whale. Ends 4 whales going South. Lat 26° 45' N Long 15° 00' W

Saturday the 2nd Jan 1836.
 This day fine weather with the exception of a haze at 6 P.M. Saw whales chased all day at 6 took one to the ship. Saw 3 whales going S.W. Lat 26° 45' N Long 15° 00' W

Sunday the 3rd Jan
 This day cut the whale commenced boiling. Land rain through the night cooled down. Ends squally. Lat 15° 05' N Long 27° 25' W

Monday the 4th Jan
 This day squally with rain. Spoke the ship India of New Bedford 14 M. 1100 lbs oil all engaged in cutting up and boiling out the whale in a rain storm. Ends. Lat 15° 05' N Long 27° 25' W

Tuesday the 5th Jan
 This day fine weather leading to the S.W. at 12 Meridian steering N.E. Saw many birds at 4 A.M. finished boiling. 75 lbs oil. Saw many small fish. Ends this day. Lat 15° 05' N Long 27° 23' W
