

Wednesday the 6th Jan 1836.

These 24 hours fine weather. Repaired 15 Cask of Oil ready for stowing 42 Breakers &c. Saw Jumpers & Grampuses many birds. Wind first part S.W. latter part S.E.

Thursday the 7th Jan 1836.

These 24 hours commences with fine breezes with overcast. Saw many jumpers. Wind 75 E. Oil in main hatchway took up 2 Cask of Oil. Saw it being black.

Friday the 8th Jan

This day rainy with fresh breezes from the East at 2 P.M. more ships to the S.W. Saw nothing and doing nothing. Wind.

Saturday the 9th Jan.

These 24 hours fresh breezes from the E. & S. Lead to the South at 6 P.M. tacked N.E. setting up. Shooks making Breakers brook out the after hold for provisions and Slops &c. Saw nothing of the whale kind. Ends this time.

Lat By Obs 26° 52' South

Sunday the 10th Jan

These 24 hours fine breezes from the S.W. & S. Lead to the East. saw 2 ships to the S.E. saw nothing of the whale kind. Ends Squally.

Lat By Obs 27° 02' South

Monday the 11th Jan

This day rugged with a bad S.E. swell leading to the South. Saw nothing of the whale kind. Repaired and bent a main topail making Breakers.

Lat By Obs 27° 25' South

Tuesday the 12th Jan 1836

This day fine breezes from the S.E. leading to the E. & S. Brook out the hold for Shooks. Lead at 12. Morison. Saw whales put off the boats took to the ships hooked on. took in. Body commenced boiling. A bad S.E. swell. Whales leading S.E. 6 or eight of them.

Wednesday the 13th Jan

This day fine weather. Cut in the other whale took in the heads a boiling. Saw many birds. Wind S.E. Lat By Obs 27° 11' South

This day fine weather all engaged in cutting up and boiling out the whales. Saw a long whale. Could not find it again. Ends finished boiling. Lat By Obs 27° 03' South

This day fine weather. Wind East. 11.00. ing N.W. and N.N.W. Brook out the hold. Started 4 pair ducks setting up. Saws. Sawing Wood &c. &c.

Lat By Obs 26° 51' South

Saturday the 16th Jan

This day fine weather. Leading to the E. & S. filled the 2 side main hatchway with Oil. more ships to the S.W. Lat By Obs 26° 15' South

Sunday the 17th Jan

This day fine weather. Saw a ship S.E. at 2 P.M. Saw a long whale put off. Struck iron Brook whale off. Leading S.W.
