

Thursday the 11th Feb 1836.

These 24 hours fresh breezes from the E
S.E. Leading to the N.E. with squalls
weather scraped the wheel saw many
birds Sun Obscured

Friday the 12th Feb

This day breezed the fore sail standing
to the South Wind E.S.E. Scraped and
misted the wheel.

Lat By Obs 26° 47' South

Saturday the 13th Feb

These 24 hours fine breezes with squalls of
rain leading to the South wind E.S.E.
saw nothing at all

Lat By Obs 27° 20' South

Sunday the 14th Feb

This day fine weather wind E.S.E. Lead-
ing to the N.E. Saw nothing of the wheel
but still the water is high over

Lat By Obs 26° 42' South

Monday the 15th Feb

These 24 hours light breezes from the N.E.
Leading to the East, making breakers,
a number of rain squalls Saw a sail
N.E. leading to the N.W. Ends.

Lat By Obs 26° 35' South

Tuesday the 16th Feb

These 24 hours commences with fine breezes
from the N.W. leading to the N.E. at 10 o'clock
A.M. Saw a shoal of small whales board
the boats chased them out of sight to
the N.W. saw a large ship to the N.E. a
small one ran across our bows steering
E.N.E.

Lat By Obs 26° 40' South

Wednesday the 17th Feb 1836

These 24 hours light airs and calm set
up the main rigging saw 2 ships. Saw
Grampuses. No obs. Sun Obscured.

Thursday the 18th Feb

These 24 hours fresh breezes from East to E.S.E.
Leading by the wind to the North and East
with a copious rain storm. Saw a few por-
poises the cooper making breakers fitted a hose
but and hope for wetting hold Ends this day
and a rainy one. Sun Obscured No obs.

Friday the 19th Feb

These 24 hours commences with hard rain wind
E.S.E. Steering to the N.E. Middle part wind
the N.E. Steering N.W. By N. Latter part
wind shifted to the N.W. none to the
N.E. hauled the fore and mizzen sprails
continual rain through the day
Sun Obscured No obs.

Saturday the 20th Feb

These 24 hours strong gale and squalls
wind N.W. leading to the North. Close reef
rain topsail main spencer set hold
Lat By Obs 27° 56' 45" West.

Lat By Obs 25° 20' South

Sunday the 21st Feb

This day light wind from W. to N.W. Steering
N.E. and N.E. Saw nothing
Lat By Obs 27° 19' W. Lat By Obs 26° 32'

Monday the 22nd Feb

This day fine breezes from N.W. to S.
Steering N.E. By E. took up 9 ground tar
casks roped them and jelled them
with oil Ends Lat By Obs 23° 41'
