Monday the 7th March
Strong gails from the E.S.E. and East. Lead
to the South. with main laying under reef of weather. Saw many birds when I shall we
main spencer sent down fore and mizzen
top galent yds. Secured the Oil on deck
both in Bow and waist. Water turned up
the Larboard wore to the N.E.

Tuesday the 8th March
Heavy squalls with high sea. Sent down
the main tops. G. yard my God to think
the wind can blow so. there is many
a little breeze now ends wind steady
to a point. No Obs.

Wednesday the 9th March
Commences more moderate and finally
calm with a bad swell. Lutting thing
their wright places. Ends wind N.E.
Lat By Obs 27° 30' South

Thursday the 10th March
These 24 hours commences with fresh N.E. and
N.E. breezes with squalls of rain wind East.
Steering S.E. By S. and S.E. fitted main
top galent yard ends under elark reef
main topsail and main spencer
Lat By Obs 28° 03' South
Lon By Obs 177° 20' 30' West,

Friday the 11th March 1836
These 24 hours N.E. wind with a bad
swell from the East. Steering South and
S.E. Saw many birds repaired main tops
Sail run and dried 2 tow lines. Saw nothing
of the whale kind. Ends this day.

Lat By Obs 29° 07' South

Saturday the 12th March
These 24 hours fresh breezes from N.E. to E.
Lead to the S.E. and South a continual
rain with thunder lightning and all sorts
of weather. Saw many birds when I shall we
get some good weather Oh dear.
No Obs. Sun in the waves.

Sunday the 13th March 1836.
These 24 hours fine weather with a clear sky
balm through the day saw one poor Phoebe of p-
puruses, dried lines. Sails & ends.
Lat By Obs 30° 39' South.

Monday the 14th March 1836.
These 24 hours commences and continues with fog
and rain. Squalls Oh! what weather we do have
making breakers break out the bluber room
Sent up main top galent and sail
Lat By Obs 31° 09' South.

Tuesday the 15th March
These 24 hours fine weather wind East. Lead
the S.E. sent an other main topsail fore top
Sails. Main spencer repairing old break
ends. Lat By Obs 32° 40' South

Wednesday the 16th March
Fine weather Wind N.E. Lead E. Saw a Ship. Saw
paired a main topsail. Lat By Obs 33° 27' South
