

Monday the 23rd May 1836.

These 24 hours commenced with Squalls from the S.W. a beating up for the Island I saw nothing whale kind

Lat 13° 32' South

Tuesday the 24th May

These 24 hours fine weather at 7 A.M. Loaded 2 boats went on shore at 4 Boats off with a load of potatoes &c. Landed on the East side the isl. Ends

Wednesday the 25th

This day got off 4 Boat loads of Potatoes, yams, figs, Coconuts &c at 4 P.M. kept off for Tahiti

Thursday the 26th May

This day fine breezes at 2 P.M. Saw Tahiti at 4 P.M. Saw Ennis a number of down for the harbour throwing away potatoes, yams &c. Ends

Friday the 27th May

This day fine at 6 A.M. Saw whales put off the boats struck took one to the Ship point Venus bearing N.E. Dis 10 miles took the whale to the Ship cut her went on shore found one run away took the Cook off Shiped one native Ends

Saturday the 28th May

This day fine weather Shiped one hand at 4 P.M. all on board head off Plewing at the whale Ends fine weather

Sunday the 29th May 1836

This day Wind from S.E. to North passed to the North and West passed to the

Monday the 30th May 1836

This day light airs & Calm Saw blackfish porpoises broke out the after hold threw potatoes away &c Lat 13° 17' S

Tuesday the 31st May

This day light airs and calm a bad swell from the South all variously engaged saw many small fish &c. Ends

Lat 13° 10' South

Wednesday the 1st June

These 24 hours light airs and calm Saw finch a bad swell from the South on last repairing mainsail Ends this day

Lat 13° 44' S

Thursday the 2nd May 1836

These 24 hours light airs and calm engaged in repairing mainsail Saw many small fish picked over the potatoes &c. Ends where is the whales Ends this day

Lat 13° 08' South

Friday the 3rd June 1836

This day light airs and calm at 10 A.M. saw whales put off took 2 to the Ship chased the others hand could not get hold of any took the whales in cut them up Calm with a bad swell from the South Ends Saw finch among the whales and conch fish.

Saturday the 4th June

These 24 hours fine East breezes Plewing Noats saw porpoises threw out the whale a swell from the S.E. Ends this day
