

Sunday the 5th June 1836

This day light breezes from Eastward heading to the North. Saw porpoises, Birds, and Small fish Ends
Lat By Obs 12° 16' South

Monday the 6th June

These 24 hours light airs and calm finished repairing mainsail bent him on bent the mizzen topsail repairing him bent a new 5th Jib. Saw many small fish a few Birds
Lat By Obs 11° 44' South

Tuesday the 7th June

These 24 hours fine breezes from the East. Steering N. and N by N. saw porpoises. Birds bent the mizzen topsail, repaired main top. G. Sail, ripped up a old mizzen top G. Sails one fore one. Ends this day
Lon By Obs 149° 00' 00" West
Lat By Obs 10° 05' South

Wednesday the 8th June

These 24 hours commences fresh breezes all Engaged in repairing sails Wind E N E. Steering N by N. and N N W. Saw porpoises a few Birds Ends this 24 hours
Lon Obs 149° 25' W. Lat By Obs 8° 30' South

Thursday the 9th June

These 24 hours fine breezes from the East steering N N W. and repairing Sails Saw nothing of the Whale kind Ends Lat By Obs 6° 14' S
Lon By Obs 150° 30' West

Friday the 10th June

These 24 hours fine weather Wind E N E. Steering to the N N W. repairing fore top sail. Saw nothing of the whale kind
Lat By Obs 4° 42' South

Saturday the 11th June 1836

This day fine Easterly breezes Steering N N W. per Compass Saw nothing of the Whale kind finished fore top. Sail repaired a flag jib brook out and washed out the Bleeker room Ends Lat By Obs 3° 07' South

Sunday the 12th June 1836

This day fine weather Wind East. Steering N N W. at 10^h saw a large whale put off at 10^h Morideon took him to the Ship with a Boat had to ¹⁰⁰⁰ Commenced cutting down at 15^h 20^h 10 30 Lat By Obs 1° 15' South

Monday the 13th June

This day fine weather finished cutting commenced Steaming made Sail Saw blackfish & Porpoises Lat By Obs 1° 39' South

Tuesday the 14th June

This day fine weather Wind East. at 10^h Morideon Saw a shoal of whales put off struck 3 parted one short work took to the Ship. Ends this day whales heading North N 31 Lat By Obs 1° 29' S

Wednesday the 15th June 1836

These 24 hours fine weather cut the whales commenced Steaming again Saw nothing of the whale kind made Sail Wind E by S Ends Lat By Obs 1° 10' South

Thursday the 16th June 1836

These 24 hours fresh Easterly winds heading to the North at 12^h W. Saw Small fish finished Steaming Ends Lat By Obs 00° 39' South

Friday the 17th June

Fresh E. winds sweeping Oct Saw many Birds Lat By Obs 1° 24' South
