

Thursday the 30th June 1836.

These 24 hours light breezes from the E & E. Steering North Middle Part & squally with rain Wind from N.W. Latter light airs from the S.E. Cooped 13 C. of Broad Br. Lat By Obs None

Friday the 1st July 1836.

This day fine weather with a light S.E. wind Steering North hauled up 8 C. of light breeze and variable Saw Birds rain in cable repaired the Ben over hauled the Iron Hoops. Saw 2 finbacks and many lubies. Lat By Obs 3° 08' North

Saturday the 2nd July

These 24 hours first and middle parts light breezes with fine weather Wind E & E. Steering North. Saw a long breach run up with the ground and over it could not find it painted the S. pane boat in side Latter rain Wind North Saw many birds. Lat By Obs 170° 52' West at 8 A.M. Lat By Obs 4° 44' North

Sunday the 3rd July

These 24 hours light breezes from the E with squalls, middle and latter squally from the N. and N.E. Saw many lubies and other birds & had swell from the N.E. a trying to get to the North. No Obs seen occurred

Monday the 4th July

These 24 hours first and middle parts light airs and calm. Latter part Saw whales put off stretch & saved the iron from boat chased until sunset came back to the South. Lat By Obs 6° 42' N.

Tuesday the 5th July 1836.

These 24 hours light breezes with squalls from the South saw many blackfish finbacks making breakers. Loaded 10 boxes to the S. and S.E. and S.W. Latter Steering North Ends Lat By Obs 7° 04' N. Lat By Obs 168° 33' 30" West.

Wednesday the 6th July

Light breezes and variable Saw Birds rain and squalls. Middle much the same Latter wind N.W. Lead North making breakers. Lat By Obs 8° 07' North.

Thursday the 7th July

These 24 hours commences and continues with squalls with rain from N.W. to West heading to the North repairing old sails. Making breakers. Lat By Obs 8° 45' West.

Friday the 8th July

This day fine & middle parts light winds from the N.W. and N.E. heading to the N. and N.E. Latter rains bent down the cutting pendants & stripped and renewed them making breakers. Ends. Lat By Obs 167° 46' West at 8 A.M. Lat By Obs 9° 27' North

Saturday the 9th July

These 24 hours light breeze much the same Latter took a breeze from N.E. By E. Steering N.W. By N. Saw lubies and other birds making breakers. No Obs seen occurred

Sunday the 10th July

These 24 hours fine breezes from the E & E Steering N.W. By N. Saw compasses Saw a few birds. Lat By Obs 12° 37' N.
