

Monday the 11th July
 These 24 hours commences with fine breezes from the E N E. Steering N W by N, all drawing sail set. Middle and latter parts wind N N E. leading to the N W. with fresh squalls. Saw nothing of the whale kind. Split the fore topmast steering sail. Lat By Obs 14th 37 N Lon 171th 50 West

Tuesday the 12th July
 This day squally wind from N N E to S E. Steering N W. and N W by N. Saw a few birds. Lat By Obs 16th 37 N Lon 173th 33 West

Wednesday the 13th July
 These 24 hours fresh breezes with heavy squalls from the East. hauled the fore & mizzen topails. Close reefed the main hoist up the foresail. Latter more moderate made sail. No Obs Sun Observed

Thursday the 14th July
 Fine breezes from E. to N E. Steering N W by N. per Compass. Saw a few birds with a plenty of squalls. Conds. Lat By Obs 20th 36 North Lon 175th 33 West.

Friday the 15th July
 This day fine N E. Breezes Steering N W by N. per Compass. Saw a few birds. Lon 177th 10 West. Lat By Obs 22th 47 North

Saturday the 16th July
 This day fine E N E. winds Steering N W by N. Saw porpoises a few birds repaired a main topail. Conds fine weather. Lon 179th 03 West. Lat By Obs 25th 33 N.

Sunday the 17th July 1836
 These 24 hours fine E N E. Breezes leading to the North. Saw several land birds. Conds papered. Several slicks. Conds at sunset short sea sail. Conds for a whale soon. Lon By Obs 179th 12.45 West at 4 P.M. Lat By Obs 27th 33 North

Monday the 18th July
 These 24 hours fine breezes at 7 P.M. Short sail 10. more S E. at 2 more back North. wind N E. at 9 A.M. Saw Ocean pt leaving N E. Dis 15 miles. Saw Jumper. Porpoises. birds etc. Lat By Obs 28th 33 North

Tuesday the 19th July
 These 24 hours fine breezes from the E N E. leading to the N W by N. at 12. Monsoon off West. Saw Jumper. a few birds. Coined the pair boat blacked the chain hoists making breakers etc. Lat By Obs 30th 03 N

Wednesday the 20th July
 This day fine weather Wind E N E. Steering N. and N N W. at 7 P.M. Spoke the Roman 8 M 350 lbs Oil a cutting. Lat By Obs 30th 25 N

Thursday the 21st July
 These 24 hours fine weather with the exception of a few squalls at 10 A.M. Saw a large whale. Ward struck him parted the line a portion line. Saw the Roman take a whale. Lat By Obs 30th 35 N.

Friday the 22nd July
 These 24 hours variable with squalls. Saw Jumper & Ships 1 Barque coiled a new line filled up the other tubs. Ender. Sun Observed. No Obs
