

Friday the 5th Aug

These 24 hours light airs and calm painting the ships stern repairing main topsail riced up old fore topsail making round lower. Saw blackfish, porpuses, Grampuses. Squid. &c. a Ship N.W. Ends this Caly
Lat By Obs 32° 50' N

Saturday the 6th Aug

These 24 hours light rise from the West. a working to the N.W. at 12 noon saw a piece of a whales Carcase. repaired and bent a main topsail painting Ships stern painted the Lead
Saw porpuses, Lat By Obs 33° 21' N

Sunday the 7th Aug 1836.

These 24 hours light breezes from the West 6 hours to the N.W. 18 to the S.W. a Trawl from the Eastward. a current setting to the East. Saw many porpuses, Grampuses, Jumpers Ends
Lat By Obs 32° 53' N

Monday the 8th Aug

These 24 hours variable with squalls of rain steering N.W. &c. Saw porpuses Jumpers Grampuses all variously engaged but when we shall catch a whale the land only know
Lat By Obs 32° 05' North

Tuesday the 9th

This day fine weather Saw every thing but sperm whales repairing a foarsail
Lat By Obs 31° 35'

Wednesday the 10th Aug

This day steering to the westward saw all but sperm whales
Lat By Obs 30° 42'

Thursday the 11th Aug 1836

These 24 hours winds from the N.E. steering N.W. and at N. Saw a Sail &c. Saw many Grampuses, Jumpers, porpuses. Finbacks. &c. repairing foarsail bent it repairing back
Lat By Obs 30° 55'

Friday the 12th Aug

This day first part light N.E. wind steering N.W. middle calm. latter a light breeze from N.E. steering West. Saw every thing but sperm whales Ends the time
Saw a Sail N.W. heading to the N.W.E
Lat By Obs 31° 05'

Saturday the 13th Aug

These 24 hours fine weather wind E.S.E. steering N.W. by N. and N.W. by N. Saw a sail N.W. net hold, saw many tide rips Ends
Lat By Obs 30° 40' North

Sunday the 14th Aug

These 24 hours fine breezes from the E.S.E. steering N.W. at 10 A.M. spoke the Millington & Liverpool packet a stunning cow oil at 12. spoke the Daniel Webster a Boiling. saw an other ship a cutting
Saw the 4 fourth we are near them I believe
Lat By Obs 28° 59' North

Monday the 15th August.

These 24 hours first part steering N.W. middle and latter N.E. and N.E. by E. Saw a whales carcase Ends
Lat By Obs 28° 04' N

Tuesday the 16th Aug

These 24 hours fine weather steering to the North. Saw a Ship East. Lat By Obs 28° 38' North
Long By Obs 172° 40' 15' East,
