

Wednesday the 17th Aug 1836

This day fine weather Wind N.E. and N.W. leading to the North West 15 hours to the S.E. By 6, Saw 2 Ships to the Eastwards
Leatt By Obs 29th 22 North

Thursday the 18th Aug

This day first and middle fine weather latter squally Saw 4 Ships all with all sail set, saw porpoises at 12 took N.W.
Leatt By Obs 28th 42 North

Friday the 19th Aug

These 24 hours fresh breezes from the N.E. of N.W. led the foretop sail at 9 A.M. at 11 set it again doubled reefed at 12 set Gill & Spanker at 3 P.M. Landed Gill & Spanker foretop sail Saw 2 Ships lead to the North passed us at 3 P.M.
Leatt By Obs 29th 15 North

Saturday the 20th Aug

These 24 hours commences squally with thick rainy weather at 2 P.M. Clear Wind S.E. lead N.E. & N.W. by N. at 6 P.M. Saw a large whale heading N.W. and the boats did not see him again
No Obs Sun Obscured



Sunday the 21st Aug

These 24 hours commences with fresh breeze from East at 5 A.M. Saw whales at 9 and at 10 took one to the ship with a cut in two. took the other whale 4 hours out of him so the ship lost the run of the boat at dark boats all returned from him the boat with the whale

Monday the 22nd Aug 1836

This day squally with a bad sea at the whales body in commences flensing Ok what a flensing time Ends
Leatt By Obs 28th 46 North

Tuesday the 23rd Aug 1836

These 24 hours fine weather all engaged in cutting up and boiling out the whale Saw a Ship N.W. a boiling latter calm
Leatt By Obs 28th 58 North

Wednesday the 24th Aug

These 24 hours first part fine weather middle and latter rainy wind variable at 6 A.M. finished boiling 35 hours Ends
Saw a Ship. Leatt Sun Obscured

Thursday the 25th Aug

These 24 hours wind all round the compass 4 or 5 times with continual rain
No Obs Sun Obscured.

Friday the 26th Aug

This day wind S.W. leading to the S.W. and S.E. by N. Saw a ship North. broke out the fore hold took up 20 cask water stowed 14 in the between decks stoad off the after hold coopered some oil for stowing Saw many finbacks.
Leatt By Obs 28th 49 North

Saturday the 27th Aug

These 24 hours fine weather stoad 80 lbs Oil in the fore hold found 2 Ground tier Cask rotten
Saw 2 Ships. Leatt By Obs 29th 17 North

Sunday the 28th Aug

This day fine weather Saw finbacks wind N.E. to S.W.
