oil in the fore hold 48 1/2 at 4 P.M.
I speak the study clerk of Newport
34 Mi. 1500 Oil, Saw 2 more Ships
Lat 17 5/8 N, Long 29 31 W

Tuesday the 13th Sept
These day fine weather I saw 5 Ships. I
to the Ship Enterprise of New Bedford
when one whale I saw her name
Dain Spencer. Lat 18 30 N

Wednesday the 14th Sept
These 24 hours fresh breeze from the N.E.
I saw finbacks, Porpoises, Pieces of Squid, 4 Ships
all heading South Eastward, making break
ers started 7 lbs deep into a pipe
Lat 18 15 N

Thursday the 15th Sept
This day fresh breeze from the N.E. at 6
M. I saw a school of small whales but off
the boats could not strike whales giving
N.E. at 4 P.M. I saw several large whales
at 6 struck. at 8 took the whale to the
Ships saw a ship S.P.H. Lat 18 39 N

Friday the 16th Sept
This day cut the whale at 11 finished making
Hail saw 3 Ships Wind N.E. cut the whale to
the leeward commenced veiling

Saturday the 17th Sept
These 24 hours fine weather I spoke the Daniel
Webster of Sag Harbour 24 50. Wilming Liverpool 34
- let New Bedford 34 Mi. 2900 lbs Oil at 3 fine
boiling 24 hours, this whale. Lat 18 46 N

Sunday the 18th Sept 1836
This day fine weather. Wind N.W. Saw
1 Ship Lat 18 09 N

Monday the 19th Sept
This day fine weather wind West N. West
steering to the S.E. of N.W. I saw a dead
whale at 5 I saw the G.L. Packet a manover
ring among whales. Saw finbacks, Porpoises.
Lat 18 59 N

Tuesday the 20th Sept
This day fine breeze I did 50 lbs Oil in the
fore hold at 3 P.M. I saw whales out off the boat
struck at 4 took one to the Ship sent the
cask off washed off 3 Ships in chase.
Lat 18 50 N

Wednesday the 21st Sept
These 24 hours fine weather looked on look
the whale in made sail at 12 commenced veiling
I spoke the Daniel Webster saw 2 other
Ships Lat 18 52 N

Thursday the 22nd Sept
This day fine weather finished veiling in
16 hours saw 2 Ships Wind E.N.E. with
pleasant Lat 18 31 N

Friday the 23rd Sept
This day Calm. fitted new cutting block for
the lower block, saw 2 Ships
Lat 18 30 N

Sunday the 24th Sept
These 24 hours fresh breeze steering S.E. at
12 at 3 P.M. wind N.W. saw a whale
- saw 2 Ships in sight. E.M.S.
Lat 18 50 N
