These 24 hours Calm with a bad swell from Eastward Saw porpoises. Lined in abundance over Low 177th 20

Latt By Obs 27th 10 PSaturday the 21st Jan

This day fresh winds from N.W. and S.E. Steaming to the South Saw nothing

Latt By Obs 27th 59 SouthMonday the 22nd Jan

This day fresh gales with rain thunder lightning. Lost reefed the main topsail hoisted Coats on the upper Coats

Latt By Obs 28th 07 PMonday the 23rd Jan

This day fine breezes with thick fog wind N.W. Steaming to the West at 6 P.M. wind hauled to the N.W. fog lifted Saw Sunday Is. bearing W. S.W. Saw a large whale one mile and a half off Sunset Sunday Is. bearing S.W. Dis 10 miles hardly that whale heading to the Eastward very slow Purdy Is.

Tuesday the 24th Jan

This day light air and calm a Steaming N.E. Sunday Is. bearing W. S.W. Dis 20 miles Saw a Sail S.E. an other W.N.W. much but and other Ship in the water Ends.

Wednesday the 25th Jan

This day fine weather wind N.W. Steaming S.E. and S.E. Saw 3 Sail. Sunday Is. bearing West. Dis 35 miles

Thursday the 26th Jan

This day wind all round with hard rain round round a bad swell from S.E. saw nothing this day partly rain.

Friday the 27th Jan

All this Day hard rain with variable winds at 6 P.M. Spoke the George Clinton of Hudson 1300 Hls Oil Ends raining

Saturday the 28th Jan

As usual hard rain wind S. and S.W. but light Steaming West. Saw the G. Clinton ends with hard rain Ok sea

Sunday the 29th Jan

This Day fine breezes but rain with rain at 6 P.M. Saw the land bearing N.W. Dis 15 miles spoke the Cortis 2100 Hls Oil

Monday the 30th Jan

This Day fine weather Saw several pieces of Spind Spoke the Braganga Saw 15 miles

Tuesday the 31st Jan

This day fine weather 6 Ships in sight at 8 Saw the Braganga manoeuvring ran off at 11 Saw whales going to the windward Saw the B. take a whale and bearing W.N.W. Dis 25 miles Ends our turn to men

Wednesday the 1st Feb

This Day fine weather Saw 4 Ships at 4 P.M. Spoke the Atlantic Merchant 1200 700 Hls of Sunday Is.

Thursday the 2nd Feb

This day fine weather Saw 5 Ships nothing off Sunday Is.

Friday the 3rd Feb

Fine weather Saw 4 Ships Saw Blackfish ran down within 2 miles the land went off at 6 Ends
