

Saturday the 4th Feb 1834

This day overcast Saw 3 Ships passing to weather of the Island 8 miles all day to the S and S E. Saw nothing

Sunday the 5th Feb

This day Commenced overcast with fine East breezes Saw 1 Ship one brig heading N N E, at 2 P. M. raining Saw the land more Ships E P E. wind N E. what weather off Sunday Isl.

Monday the 6th Feb

This day fine breezes from the Eastward with rain & squalls at 10 A. M. Saw a long whale board the boats could not find the run of the whale heading in for the land Saw the G. Chetw. a Chasiney Land West 210 miles Saw a Sail B

Tuesday the 7th Feb

This day light air & Calm repaired a Oil Grain to sail and bent him bent on a Oil Grain to sail, on bent the Grain one Saw 3 Ships Ends this day Saw porpoises

Wednesday the 8th Feb

This day fresh S P E. winds ran down close the 1st spoke the Braganza Ends

Thursday the 9th Feb

This day fresh winds S P E. ran down under the lee of the little isle to the weather Sunday 1st took off 5 boat loads of fine weed 4 Ships ran down Ends lead off N E.

Friday the 10th Feb

Fresh winds and rugged ran under the lee caught some fine fish 5 Ships in the

Saturday the 25th Feb

This day calm cut the whale Saw the Braganza a whaling at 5 a light breeze commenced sailing S P E. wind Lon 172° 59' 30" W. Lat 13° 02' 25" S

Sunday the 26th Feb

This day fine weather all engaged in hoisting & starting cash for oil 3 of Corn. 4 of Flour 4 Pipes Heads, etc. Saw the Braganza Lon 175° 29' 30" W. 25° 10' No Ols this day

Monday the 27th Feb

This day fresh breezes cooeping oil to go below pass to the leeward Braganza a bad swell Ends No Ols 25° 15' Lon By Chron 175° 39' 30"

Tuesday the 28th Feb

This day fresh breezes & rugged smooth cut the after hold commenced stowing

Wednesday the March 1st

This day fresh South wind with rain secured the cash on deck Ends with a bad Sea Leading S P E. No Ols

Thursday the 2nd March

A gail from the South coopered some oil cash struck the Reef down the beam room Lat By Ols 23° 28' S

Friday the 3rd March

This day more moderate finished stowing oil cleared the deck wind S. Leading N P W. a bad swell Lon Chron 174° 12' 15" Lat By Ols 23° 12'
