

Friday the 31st March 1837
This 24 hours not quite so much rain with
calm. with a few squalls. I took a barrow of
oil in fore hold and 700 breakers
No Ob. Sun Obscured

Saturday the 1st April 1837
These 24 hours fine breezes from ESE. Sent
up some tops & yds and I sail sent out viz
Jib down but I sail I spoke the pale line
of Salem 17 ton 950 lbs oil at 6 P.M. Came
to in Cuthberts harbour in 14 fathoms
water fine harbour. Saw the land at day
light

Sunday the 2nd April
Fine weather on watch on liberty sailed
the Elizabeth & Capt Post. Ends in port

Monday the 3rd April
Fine weather Went 200 lbs Empty Cask on
shore washed ship out. Vides. Arrived
ships St George & Illinois. Blacked the
lands &c. in harbour

Tuesday the 4th April
Fine weather took up 150 lbs oil. Came
enced cooping. St. Apt. hold. Found the
oil rather thick. Ends

Wednesday the 5th April
Fine weather finished cooping washed off
ends

Thursday the 6th April
Fresh trade winds with rain squalls
took off some water from shore

Friday the 7th April
Took off 3 boat loads more I sawing W. G.

Saturday the 8th April 1837
Fresh breezes with some rain & Canachers
ran away one white man took off a raft
of water. I sawing wood and water one
watch on liberty. Ends

Sunday the 9th April 1837
A few squalls of rain took off some wood
one watch on liberty. Will blue ran away

Monday the 10th April
Fine with the exception of a few squalls of rain
the natives brought Bill Blue back took off 3 boat
loads more raft of water

Tuesday the 11th April
Fine weather took 1 boat load more but
a main to sail I took off the hold &c.

Wednesday the 12th April
Fine weather 2 boats a trading took on board
17 bags vegetables &c. Fruit &c.

Thursday the 13th April
Fine weather shipped 4 loads all ready for
sea. Ends at day light took our anchor boat
out

Friday the 14th April
At 9 A.M. went on shore at the Cove
took off 13 bags a large log of wood
at 4 left off for ends

Saturday the 15th April
Fresh breezes at 8 went on shore being
Sunday cannot trade. Sent the boat off

Sunday the 16th April
at day 2 boats on shore took off 5 boat
loads yams. 22 bags 3 of Coconuts 1 of taro.
