This day fresh breezes from the N.E. lead to the N.N.W. and N.W. By N. parted the Eastropes four topsail to the m topsail maintopg. Sail. Saw many porpoises. a bad sea from the N.E.

Monday the 5th June

This day fresh breezes from E.N.E. to E. By leading to the N.N.W. & N.W. By N. with a lead sea, with heavy squalls all variously engaged. To ends this time

Lat By Obs 5^h 40 North

Tuesday the 6th June

These 24 hours fresh breezes with squalls heavy rain wind N.E. leading to the N.N.W. & N.W. By N. a bad sea from the N.E. saw many birds ends

Wednesday the 7th June

These 24 hours first part calm head a light air from the N.E. leading to the East latter E.N.E. wind N.E. repaired a main topsail on board the mainsail engaged in repairing it Lon 177^h 44^m 00 W. Lat By Obs 7^h 44 North

Thursday the 8th June

These 24 hours commences with light breezes from the N.E. leading to the E.N.E. at 12 midnight turned N.N.W. latter part wind N.N.E. leading to the N.W. finished repairing mainsail sent him sent an other main topsail ends.

Friday the 9th June 1837

These 24 hours fine trade winds leading N.N.W. and North passed Barbours set no appearance of land saw a few birds the watch variously engaged

Saturday the 10th June

This day fine breezes from E.N.E. to East steering to the N. & N.N.W. saw a few birds passed to the windward of the place appeared for Pedra de No appearance of land variously engaged

Sunday the 11th June

This day fine breezes from the N.E. By E. & E.N.E. leading to the North & N.N.W. saw a shoal of porpoises. ends.

Monday the 12th June

These 24 hours light N.E. & E.N.E. breezes lead to the North & N.N.W. sent down the cutting pendant to striped and filled then turning down rigging &c ends

Tuesday the 13th June

This day fine East breezes steering North engaged in taring rigging setting up pipe shoops. saw a few birds ends this day

Lat By Obs 16^h 21 North

Wednesday the 14th June

These 24 hours light breezes from East to N.E. lead to the North. saw a few birds a shoal of porpoises. engaged in taring rigging repairing old water cask &c. ends
