These 24 hours fine breezes from the N.E. & N.E. by E. engaged in making breakers taking Riggins etc. Saw nothing of the whale kind no so not know when we shall cross

Lat By Obs 19° 58' N.

Friday the 16th June
These 24 hours fine breezes from N.E. & N.E. by E. making breakers Saw a shoal of porpoises Engaged in repairing and taking rigging in ends whales soon. Lat By Obs 19° 34' N.

Lat By Obs 21° 52' N.

Saturday the 17th June
These 24 hours fine breezes from N.E. to East E. Course N.N.W. with all drawing sail set. Saw a few birds making walking steep breakers etc. Saw nothing of the whale kind.

Lat By Obs 24° 11' North

Sunday Monday the 18th June
These 24 hours fine breezes from the E. & N.E. steering N.N.W. Saw a few birds a shoal of Grampuses. Ships taking 24 to 30 fathoms in 24 hours Ends this day.

Lat By Chronometer 177° 33' 15" E. at 4 P.M.

Lat By Obs 26° 11' North

Tuesday Wednesday the 19th June
Piers & middle parts light E. & N.E. breezes steering N.N.W. Low compass latter calm washed the ship round out side. Saw many porpoises & Grampuses Ends.

Lat By Obs 27° 21' North

Tuesday Wednesday the 20th June
Calm through painted ship out side all night and saw a piece of squid. Lat By Obs 27° 46' South

Wednesday the 21st June
First and middle light air and calm with a few light squalls of rain at 6 P.M. Spoke the Henry Astor painter water ways. Lat By Obs 28° 11' N.

Thursday the 22nd June
Light air and calm painted four of main masts painted & varnished. Spoke the Henry Astor at 5 P.M. at 10 P.M. Spoke the Illinois. Lat By Obs 29° 45' N.

Friday the 23rd June
This day light air & calm at 4 P.M. Saw the Illinois & Henry Astor among whales. Board the boats. Chased until dark came on. Copied Illinois took a whale. Lat By Obs 29° 00' N.

Saturday the 24th June
Light air & calm round round painted the cabin the two foremen ships in sight. Lat By Obs 29° 00' N.

Sunday the 25th June
These 24 hours calm & ships in sight. Saw nothing of the whale kind. Ends. Lat By Obs 28° 58' N.

Monday the 26th June
This day light breezes from the South steering North at 12 meridian lifted to the E. & N.E. & ships in sight. Sent down main top & mast. engaged in putting on other painting cabin etc. Saw a finbacks Ends. Lat By Obs 29° 27' N.

Lat By Obs 176° 10' 15" East at 4° 30' P.M.
