

Monday the 10 July 1837

This day light air and calm at 4 P. M. saw whales put off the boats struck one took him to the ship chased the other & not get hold of any of them Saw about 25 whales Lon By Chron 174° 39 East. Lat By Obs 29° 15 North

Tuesday the 11th July

These 24 hours fine breezes at 5 A. M. looked on at 8 the whale in made sail saw a school of whales put off the boat & D. and from one took one to the ship cleared the deck, commenced steaming at 10 A. M. about 29° 25 whales going N. W. Lat By Obs 29° 15 North

Wednesday the 12th July

These 24 hours fine weather were ships took the whale in made sail saw 2 ships at 12 took E. N. E. at 4 P. M. none I saw saw nothing whale kind setting up and looking out the whales. Lat By Obs 29° 39 East Lon By Chron 174° 36' 15 E at 5° 20 P. M.

Thursday the 13th July

These 24 hours fine weather heading to the Southward saw finbacks at 12 merid on finished boiling 42 hours & no Lon Chron 174° 30' 45 E. Lat By Obs 29° 11 North

Friday the 14th July

This day fine breezes filled the try callos set up 6 P. M. Thook saw 2 ships Lon Chron 175° 01' 15 E. Lat By Obs 29° 08 North

Saturday the 15th July

These 24 hours S. E. wind a working ship for a whale saw 1 ship stored 6 pipes of oil below Lat By Obs 29° 11 North

Sunday the 16th July 1837

These 24 hours light breezes from the South ding to the East & N. E. at 11 A. M. spoke Orion Nantucket 9 M. 300 lbs oil at 5 P. M. runner now 10 350 lbs oil. Lat By Obs 29° 42 North

Monday the 17th July

These 24 hours light South wind heading to the Southward saw jumpers porpoises. 80 Cooper's pipes of oil for blowing Lat By Obs 30° 13 North at 8 A. M. 176° 11' 15 East

Tuesday the 18th July

These 24 hours fine weather Head between sails pipes oil saw nothing whale kind Lat By Obs 30° 27 North

Wednesday the 19th July

This day light wind from the South on the kind to the E. S. E. saw nothing at all set up 6 pipes. Lon By Chron 177° 20 at 5 P. M. Lat By Obs 30° 01 North

Thursday the 20th July

These 24 hours light S. E. breezes steering E. & N. by E saw jumpers. Grampuses. saw a sail standing to the S. Westward. Lat By Obs 30° 11 North

Friday the 21st July

These 24 hours light air and calm at 4 P. M. saw about 6 whales 5 miles off land the boats at 7 took one to the ship with stove boat. Whales going N. W. this one that got from W. Bay South Lon 179° 50 East 111 Barrels of oil Lat By Obs 31° 09 North No 58 179° 50 E
