Sunday the 23rd July

These 24 hours light air and calm weather
up to boiling out the whale & ships one
large in sight Latt By Obs 31° 26' N

Monday the 24th July

This day fine breezes with a few squalls
Saw 3 ships to the windward manœvering
among whales one took a whale 5 ships
1 large in sight finished boiling in
48 hours Latt By Obs 31° 25' N

Tuesday the 25th July

This day light air and calm Saw 5 ships
Set up 6 pipe & hooks saw nothing of the whale
kind Latt By Obs 31° 27' N

Wednesday the 26th July

This day light air and calm 10 sail in
sight a steaming to the W. & W. mine 250
variable at 4 P. M. Coast down a boat
went on board North America 25 M.
1300 bbls Oil Latt By Obs 31° 28' N

Thursday the 27th July

This day light air Steaming to the W. & W.
& ships in sight cooping pipes of oil
a strong current setting at 6. Saw porpoise
pieces of squid in abundance Ends.
Latt By Obs 31° 23' West.
Obs 179° 22' 15 W

Friday the 28th July 1837

These 24 hours light air Steaming to the W. & W. a ship
in sight. Saw a large break could not find
it again Stead 17 Cask of oil between decks
at 90 fath. with 11 pounds of the same
Strong current to S. & E. Latt By Obs 31° 51' North

Saturday the 29th July

These 24 hours light variable winds a morning to the
S. & West Saw porpoises & jumpers
Latt By Obs 31° 30' North

Sunday the 30th July

These 24 hours commences calm. Middle Squally
from S. & W. Leading S. & W. and West. Saw
jumpers & pieces of squid on saw no mine
Latt By Obs 179° 15' 15 West at 6 P. M.
Latt By Obs 31° 15' N

Monday the 31st July

These 24 hours light variable winds made mine
Saw nothing of the whale kind Ends
Latt By Obs 179° 15' 15 W. at 6 P. M.

Tuesday the 1st Aug

These 24 hours light variable winds from
the S. & W. mostly working Southerly
Saw 4 ships. Exchanged signals with a
bright sided ship without a lead blew with
a white ensign. Latt By Obs 31° 11' N

Wednesday the 2nd Aug

Calm with a few cats laws Saw many Grampuses
& ships in sight. Latt 179° 37' W. Latt By Obs 30° 59'

Thursday the 3rd Aug

Light winds and calm with a strong
current to the S. & E. 5 ships in sight Saw
many Grampuses Latt By Obs 30° 47'
