

Tuesday the 26th Sept 1837

All these 24 hours strong breezes from the N.W. steering E.P.E. with all Sailing Sail set

Lat By Obs 29° 45' N

Wednesday the 27th Sept

These 24 hours commences with strong breezes from North steering E by S. Middle land rain latter a gail from N.E. Saw hiebs many war birds and other Ends this 24 hours

Lat By Obs 28° 44' N

Thursday the 28th Sept

These 24 hours commences with fresh Gails from the N.E. with squalls heading to the N.W. Latter more moderate but the topsails wore to the E. at 5 A. Ends those hard hours

Lat By Obs 29° 26' N

Friday the 29th Sept

All these 24 hours fresh breezes from the N.E. heading to the E.P.E. at 12 mid night backed to the N.W. Saw a Sail Eastward sent a new mainsail an other maintopsail Ends this 24 hours

Lat By Obs 29° 17' N

Saturday the 30th Sept

These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from the E.N.E. Middle wind shifted to the South steering E by East. Saw a Manque to the Eastward an english Ends this day No whales here

Lon 172° 30' West

Lat By Obs 29° 50' N

Sunday the 1st Oct 1837

Commences with moderate breezes from the N.W. attended with rain steering E.N.E. with all Sailing Sail set latter rain from N.W. ends these 24 hours

Lat By Obs 28° 55' North

Monday the 2nd Oct

These 24 hours commences with light breezes from the N.W. with overcast heading to the E.N.E. Middle and latter parts rain & E. with rain squalls backed to the E.N.E. Saw Gram puses. Coiled two new tow lines Ends

Lon 170° 20' West of Greenwich

Lat By Obs 29° 51' North

Tuesday the 3rd Oct

These 24 hours commences & continues with light winds from N.W. steering E.N.E. Sent down four topsail yards sent up a new one sent a new four topsail a bad swell from the Westward

Lat By Obs 30° 00' N

Wednesday the 4th Oct

Commences calm with rain a swell from W. Middle much the same latter a light breeze from the West with overcast. steering E.N.E. Ends this day

Lat By Obs Sun Observed

Thursday the 5th Oct

This day commences with moderate breezes from West with rain latter fresh breezes from N.W. steering E.N.E. rised up an old main topsail Ends this day
