

Friday the 6th Oct 1837

These 24 hours strong breezes from the N.W. at 10 A.M. saw whales at 3 P.M. boarded the boats at 8 A.M. took the whale to the ship with a stoven boat a heavy swell from the westward.

Saturday the 7th Oct

This day fine weather out the whale made sail commenced steaming, saw a Whalesound Eastward ends this day

Sunday the 8th Oct

These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from the S.W. and pleasant weather steering E.N.E. at 5 P.M. squally scable ruffled the topsails. Calm through the night at 3 A.M. finished coaling. Saw the Abigail ends this day

No Ob. Sun Obscured

Monday the 9th Oct

Strong breezes with rain, thunder, & light -ning wind S.W. wind shifted N.W. and cleared. Abigail in sight to the Southward we must have some more oil before we go in some low or an other low ends

Tuesday the 10th Oct

All these 24 hours moderate breezes from the N.W. & steering E.N.E. Saw blackfish. Coaled the boats could not strike ship. Abigail in sight to the N.N.E.

Wednesday the 11th Oct 1837

Commences with light airs from the West wind steering E by N, with pleasant weather latter calm. P. Stood below 40 lbs oil left between the decks

Making on board about 2000 lbs

Thursday the 12th Oct

Commences with light breezes from the South and pleasant weather steering E.N.E. Engaged in ridding down rigging ship Abigail in company. Saw Gnarps

Lat By Ob. 29° 24 N

Friday the 13th Oct

Fine breezes from the South heading to the E.N.E. Ship Abigail in company. Engaged fitting rigging. Saw fimbriae and porpoises many birds. Ends this 24 hours boarded the Abigail got some potatoes

Lat By Ob. 29° 40 N

Saturday the 14th Oct

Commences with pleasant breezes from S.W. Middle part squally heading to the E.N.E. a heavy swell from the N.W.

Low By Ob. 156° 40 West

Lat By Ob. 30° 04 North

Sunday the 15th Oct

Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. with a bad sea. Ruffled ruffled the topsails. Paped the Abigail. Saw a turtle
