

Thursday the 26th Oct 1837

Three 24 hours fresh breezes with fine weather
Cut the whale made Tail & Steaming P.P.W.
at 1 P.M. Saw whales put off struck one
& a calf took them to the ship's head
of the cable started Pinks saw the land bearing N.W.
at 6 1/2 35 lbs. Lat 21° 45' N

Friday the 27th Oct

Three Breezes cut the whale made Tail
Steering in for Monree all engaged in
cutting up and boiling out the whales
Ran down past Monree & Sound to Oahu
at 2 A.M. have a bark until day light
Ends this day and night

Lat By Als 21° 36' N

Saturday the 28th Oct

Three Breezes at 6 A.M. Saw Oahu kept off
for Diamond Head at 4 A.M. finished stow-
ing at 11 Came to in 10 fathoms water out
side the bar, the Outer Buoy on land bearing
N by W the town Point bearing N by E

Sunday the 29th Oct

Calm weighed anchor received a pilot on board
toad in to the inner harbour with the assist-
ance of the ship's boats in harbour moored
Ship shamed the Deck Port 20 men on shore
on liberty 4 men with the Survey.

Monday the 30th Oct

Pleasant weather sent the empty water
cask on shore washed ship out till
cooper oil for to flow Dneaks up Steerage
Boat steers in Forecastle Ends
in other.

Tuesday the 31st Oct 1837

Fine weather had a Survey on the Beddons on
Ship it sent it on shore to has a new
head finished Steaming oil, washed the ship
inside all ready for calking next day
cork and how I shall feel to morrow I know
not but had enough Now in Oahu.

Wednesday the 1st Nov

Fine pleasant weather had 7 calkers at work
calking out side one watch on shore on
liberty the other a tending upon the
calkers &c. Ends in the harbour of Oahu
a very good harbour if you have work to
do but rather dear as to the charges.

Thursday the 2nd Nov

Moderate westerly Breezes the calker in-
geet on the Starboard side the Pains
are very much open the ship has suffered
for want of Ourn one watch on shore
on liberty the other employs variously
Ends in Oahu.

Friday the 3rd Nov

Fresh westerly breezes with thick rainy
weather with thunder. Lightning rain &c
nothing done this day that forward is over
getting out Ends in Oahu

Saturday the 4th Nov

Fine weather with the regular trade
wind the calkers at work the cooper
letting up Shooks &c ends this week and
day in Oahu.
