fitted the Riggin &c, one boats crew on shore

Sunday the 12th Nov

All this 24 hours fine weather with the
regular trade wind all hands except 3 on
phone on liberty at sunset all returned
went to church a sermon from Pres Mr Seal
Leamans Chaplin at Sandwich isls
in oahu.

Monday the 19th Nov

Variable winds with rain took of from
Phone five coat loads wood flound it away
one watch on shore on Liberty failed the
Ship Ansel Jills on a cruise for oil
in water.

Tuesday the 14th Nov

Variable winds with rain. I could take
on Roane a boat load of Sweet potatoes
& float them away, had weather this cannot do
much this weather ends.
