Fine weather loosed and David Pails finished painting out Side of boat away some water & took some tannos on Board. Some fruit, had a fine battle up at the usual place in company with several gentlemen and found several Ladies already there a bathing Ends in Tahiti.

Saturday the 6<sup>th</sup> Jan

This day fine weather being Sunday sent all hands on Shore on liberty at Sunset all came off. had a long pleasant walk under the fruit trees and stopped to see tannos. Ends in Tahiti

Sunday the 7<sup>th</sup> Jan

This day fine weather painted. Ships in Side Paired the Ship Caroline of and for London. had a call from the Rev Mr Smith and his British Majesty's cousin at Tahiti Ends in Tahiti

Monday the 8<sup>th</sup> Jan

This day fine weather finished painting. sent one watch on Shore on liberty. Arrived Ship Alexander Coffin of Nantucket 16 months 350 bls Oil from the of Shore ground last Capt Conger Had a small walk and bathed &c in Tahiti

Saturday the 20<sup>th</sup> Jan 1838

Fine weather man down to Mr Charles Sanders is next to the Shore in company Brother Self did not land head to the shore

Sunday the 21<sup>st</sup> Jan

Fine weather Standing to the North at 6 P.M. have a back at 2 A.M. run down for huahane Lancaster in company

Monday the 22<sup>nd</sup> Jan

Went on Shore got off 2 Cogs of wood 2500 Oranges. pigs. fowls. Fruit &c Ship a man. Ends head out between huahane and Piateru Ends Lancaster in company

Tuesday the 23<sup>rd</sup> Jan

Fine weather stood down 50 bls oil in the after hatchway between the decks which makes 2120 bls taking 20 per cent and not counting. makes Lat By Ols 16° 50 South

Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup> Jan

These 24 hours fine breezes from the N.W. with cloudy weather Steering S by E with all sails set all variously engaged in fitting Ship for bad weather Ends these 24 hours all full Ship Lancaster in company

Lat By Ols 20° 40 South

Thursday the 25<sup>th</sup> Jan

Commanded with fine breezes from N.W. Steering S by E. Latter wind from N.W. with overcast, Ship Lancaster in company saw nothing of the whale kind Ends this 24 hours all braving Sails set all variously engaged
