Saturday the 27th Jan Commences with light breezes from West fine weather at 6 P.M. Saw light bearing S.W. by W. Dis 35 or 40 miles Shortened Sail lay by through the night Lancaster in company Lat 12° 58' S Long 149° 04' W

Sunday the 28th Jan All these 24 hours fresh wind from N.W. with thunder lightning wind and rain Steering South with all necessary Sea Hot Ship Lancaster in company Ends the 24 hours variously engaged Lat 12° 58' S Long 149° 04' W

Monday the 29th Jan Commences with fresh breezes from S.W. with rain at 2 P.M. wind shifted to the South tacked to S.W. Latter Squally Double reefed Lat 12° 58' S Long 149° 04' W

Tuesday the 30th Jan Breezes from South and S.E. by the wind to the S.W. repaired J. Parker & Mac in Spencer Ship Lancaster in company Lat 12° 58' S Long 149° 04' W
