myself went to Lady Davis. Mrs Mrs
Miss Parker Cole and Talbot

home. passed a pleasant eve. A storm
very heavy. Richard wife sent me the best large

Thurs 4th This morn went out shopping. taking
Lillian with me. A vessel arrives today
bound to Boston. have not heard the name
of the vessel. The Capt is Loranion he belongs
in Newburyport Mass. Today have been
writing a pair of socks for Leggie Carter.
Mr Brightman called tonight. Capt says give
me the picture today

Friday 5th This morn Capt Pollock arrives. returns for
his papers and left again in the afternoon.
After dinner went out with Lee. The mail
steamer arrived at 4 min. I took Mrs Owen
Mr & Mrs Walter Munn. Mrs Talbot. passed
the eve here waiting for the mail. we
had but one letter from Burpee and
ten Ynigant papers. The Capt of the Steamer
called. we sent for pictures this morn

Sat 6th Here had a very lively day. This afternoon
from 1 to 4 with Lee. Lillian has passed the
day at Mrs Mosewells. She sent me this
morn the pictures of her two children.
ours that we set for pictures are very good
Tonight. have finished a pair of socks for Mrs
Lillian.

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Nov 6th This morn we went to the Chapel. rec'd
Mr Cather Jacob Fred Luke 11th 5th 9th
Mr Brightman called this afternoon. this morn
met Mr Howland. who is going down
with us. and was introduced to him
this eve have been to Church with Mrs
Carol. rec'd Bishop Whitehead's preach
from Providence. an excellent sermon

Since our return Lee has written to Mrs
Saul and I have written to Helen (Lillian).
This eve has been celebrated as Guy Fawkes
eve by the firing of rockets and
the burning of images of him in effigy.
Mrs Cole and Maggie (Mrs Parker) and
Pete and Mrs Owen passed the eve here
came to bid me goodbye. William Jamieson
called this afternoon. The Java Steamer sailed
today. I have knit a pair of socks for Bob Pollock.

Nov 7th Lillian has passed the day with Lady
Davis. Mr Brightman called this eve
Mr Loranion has been discharged today
he is going out Ship Keeper of the Ynigant
Smith when it arrives Capt Loranion's arm is
now so much better he is ready for sea
whenever the vessel arrives. Mrs Jamieson
called again tonight also Mr Cole. a
North German ship that arrived yesterday
has been surveyed and will be repaired
the Seawall Capt Thompson has completed
her repairs will be ready for sea tomorrow.
The Starlight also expects to sail tomorrow.

Nov 8th This morn sent a suit of clothes to Lillian
for Mrs Owen. have mailed two pictures of
mine of the Pollock children a picture of the Pollock
Mr Jamieson and his daughter Minnie went
shopping this morn and called on Mrs Pollock
this afternoon. Lady Davis and Mrs Owen have
called sent me a beautiful basket and a
basket of fruit. I have had company this
eve. Cooper has also called. Mrs Munn Smith
has arrived. I have written to John and Abner. sent
