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 Chase & I have had a pleasant day the D.C. Man
 arrived this morn. I had of the letters
 of the House. I had also sent from home
 mine and sent to F.H. when the money
 made for last trip in about two days
 after the receipt of F.H. I called at Mrs
 Lewis house here made a lace collar
 pocket book, and cut a white case
 skirt and vest. Truly.

Early 7th Capt. Richmond and Linsen in the Illinois
 arrived this morn. they have passed the
 eye with me. Capt. C. brought me a
 package of papers and letters from H.H. Eule.
 I went again to the Post Office today and
 got some papers. Some of them have
 been long since the papers I have
 been looking or waiting nearly all day
 have prepared a box to send home by
 Capt. Richmond. gave it him tonight
 have also packed a box for George.
 This morn the alarm of fire was given
 they said it was the Hotel but it
 proved to be out several miles up the
 valley at Waikiki Capt. R. and I have
 passed the evening with me.

Lab. 8th This morn went down to Mr. Cartwright's
 to see if he had any letters for George
 and also to tell him not to leave my
 letters at this Hotel unless I give you
 to receive them. I met his clerk on the
 way with a letter for me from Pamela
 Butler written March 1st where it has
 been for the three months I am unable
 to say. The Queen Emma sailed today. Capt. R.
 has gone. he called just before leaving. The
 Illinois has gone tonight but Capt. Henson

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has not gone will leave tomorrow afternoon.
 I sent a package of papers and letters
 I have written and one I sent from H.H.
 Eule. The Acers Barns arrived last night
 Capt. Allen accompanied with us. He went
 on board to go to sea this afternoon
 He came upland to take up the anchor
 the wanted to have Robert here. Mr. Child
 with a guard from the Garrisonists went
 off to yell the meeting just down men
 in issue, have not heard whether they
 have gone out or not. The vessel took
 to H.H. Eule on the passage. The Illinois
 nothing. The Active Campbell arrived today.
 Capt. Campbell called this evening I
 like him very much. The Small Fox is on
 the increase and new cases reported to
 day it is compared to the nature of
 present. I went down to Dr. McEwen to-
 night and was vaccinated and also
 had Charles vaccinated again.

Sun 9th This morn went to the Bethel & Society school
 and morning service. Left Lake at 10th this morn
 went to St. Paul St. Capt. Smith arrived. He called
 when I left. but soon stopped. Mrs. Webster
 sat with him until he went to sleep. He
 kept this one was Lake 7th & 8th Capt.
 Henson left this afternoon. I saw Charles
 Smith. He said. the first time I have seen
 him although he says he has seen me before
 but I did not recognize him. Capt. Campbell
 sat in church with me this morn and
 came a part of the way home with me.

Monday 10th This morn called on Mrs. Van Helt, Mrs. Butler
 and Mrs. Johnson. Capt. Campbell called this
 eve. have written to Father & Pamela to go to the
 North Star house daily tomorrow per S. H.
