Monday 17th You had a very warm day this morning after going fast to school with Lullie & best & the family met did a little washing. Since then have been working on a white sack. This eve called at Mrs Oats but found no one at home. Mrs Dr Smith called this morning invited me to spend next Saturday with her at Waikiki. My arm is getting along very well it is very sore. Mrs Herbert is moving up into the rooms opposite mine.

Tues 18th This morning Lullie and I went to the Play with Mrs Stevens and Clara had a very pleasant time. The scenery is very beautiful. returned about half past two. This eve there has been a meeting here of the American citizens of Honolulu to see about a festival of celebration they agreed to celebrate the day and the different committees were appointed Capt David Smith and wife also called thought passed the eve with me. Mrs Rickman called this morning while I was away.

Wednesday 19th Have been working on Mrs Herberts Machine today for the first time got along fine the eve Clara and I have been to the Bethel & the Young Men. There has been another meeting of American Citizens here tonight there was considerable satisfaction with the arrangements of having a new Program me has been adopted. This one promises for fine work and a Ball in the evening to be given at the Hotel. Mrs Castanaga called this eve while I was away.

Thurs 20th This morning called at Mrs Leach but she was not at home. then went to Mrs Damons and spent a couple of hours with my mother. This eve after getting Lullie asleep I went to a Wednesday Supper at the East St Church. enjoyed it very much. We had Spauld we gathered at the same day in three different languages. The English Hawaiian, and the language of the Gilbert Islanders. Song by Mr and Mrs Brigham.

Friday 21st

This morning cut out my blue silk skirt and have stitched up the seams on Mrs Herberts Machine. went down street this afternoon called on Mrs Castanaga for seventy five dollars and found my brother would not take it. This eve have been with Lullie to a Temperance Lecture in the Bethel.

This morning early went to Waikiki to Dr Smiths with Mrs Herbert, Clara, and Lullie. passed a very pleasant day. I have not felt very well. There is a whaler ship laying off and we can see it from the Dis but I have not heard what one it is.

Sun 23rd

This morning went to the Bethel, heard a sermon from Rev Mr Charles of Hawaii. found Parsons 8th 14th. The work that evening yesterday was the Joseph Maxwell. Cloud. Mr Leach called this eve with Capt Hickmott I sent two letters and some papers to him they sail tomorrow. Mr Envergreen has called a few minutes today. I did not go out this eve as Capt H and Mr Leach were here about the time of service.
