not able to be up. The Union arrived

inform me of the arrival and that they
were at his house. I called there later of the

& brought a few passengers and mails, they
will return as soon as the Nebraska
arrives. I recd six letters from John, Aunt

had sent me a paper. N. B. Stedman but
I have not recd it yet. The Mobergo
brought the report of the arrival of the
Cape May, made a very long passage. 28 days.
Mr. Matthews the Co. St. Consul returned
by the M. the English Bishop has arrived
having been. I attended the Bethel this
morning and took 24 this eve, Mrs
Herbert seems better today

Monday 1st This morn went down street this afternoon
recd another letter and a paper
sent to me by the carrier. The letter
was from Hattie. has been at work on the
suffles for my dress. Mrs Herbert is
better.

Tuesday 2nd The Nebraska arrived this morn. Thomas
Katie and Louisa Walker came and stopped
here. I have been with them all day.
This eve went out to ride with them
Capt and Mrs Lelette. Mr & Mrs Demore
also and Mrs Demore and Miss offers
have been here some to call on as with
others on them. The house is full tonight
but no arrangements have arrived

Wednesday 3rd Have been sewing about with Kate all day
they started at four o'clock this afternoon
in the Mobergo. Mr. Christie has come also Mr
Stevens. July broke the acquaintance of Mr. Williams

I feel very tired and also very lonely
