

The morn of the 4th was beautiful and bright he was at day and shaded breakfast. I had not eight cents given him he had numerous pieces of fine crochets and as a matter of course was very happy. I helped Mrs Herbert cheer to the Parlor at a party to show Mr. Whitney called to take me in his carriage to church. The service was good and even thing faded off. I had the honor to be one of the choir. He sang American and The Splendid Banner. Mrs. Whitney took me home by coach met with Lullie Clark and Mr. Egerton on board. The Dr. I thought was Paraganeath and introduced the Regatta. At ten o'clock after dinner I made for the Ball. Lullie left at ten and he wore a white suit with a red and blue necktie. I wore a blue and white silk skirt with white ornament and jacket over short coat up with blue hose a blue belt of ribbon at the throat and red flowers in my hair. I sat of until half past one but not done as I had not here. I had several invitations to do so. There was a very pleasant picnic at Mrs. Pierce's (the American Mission) but I did not attend as I had no carriage and it was too far to walk.

Friday 5th

This morn I started to go to New York City by Lullie's School till out but did not go to the street and fair is so low nobody left to take so they walk. Call at Mrs. D. Smith's. This afternoon I have been sewing in my room after dinner I went to bed with Mrs. D. Smith.

Sat 6th

Have had a new warm day I have been sewing the ruffle on my silk dress which finished it this eve and am much pleased with it. Called tonight at Capt. Cat's with Mrs. Herbert Clara Mr. Clark and Lullie but found the family absent. The boat arrived today bringing a few days later than from the East I have rec'd nothing. This eve the Semmonens League gave another concert at the Theatre. I did not attend. The Paraganeath sailed today. She does another way week.

Sunday 7th

This morn went to the Parthet. This morn were written to take Katie this eve have been to East Street Church, and feel very weary with the labor of the day. I played the organ for the Sunday School this morn. as there was no one else there to do it.

Mon 8th

Went down street this morn. bought dress for Lullie two suits of clothes. One more and out and basket one suit then started all I could by machine. Lullie has been out riding with Mr. Sauters family.

Tues 9th

Went down to the Post Office this morn and mailed my letter then went up to Mrs. Smith's to pass the day. Lullie had a severe fall while we were there. Lullie's hair is very long. I called at Mrs. Lullie's on my way. Her two children are quite sick with colds and Lullie is very weak and complains of a sore throat tonight. While I was absent today Mrs. Cat called about Mrs. Darnell and Mrs. Bolter called with her passing to take me out to ride. Lullie's dress is very good.
