Wed 10th

Have had a warm day with frequent showers. I stitched a little for Mrs. Fisher. This morn. we have been making another suit for Lillian. This eve. have been to the Bethel prayer meeting. This afternoon we had three invitations to attend the meeting of the Shropshire Friends Society at Mrs. Fox's. Tomorrow afternoon at four. I shall not go so early but wait to meet Lillian in West before I go, and shall not go then unless he is called. He has a very severe cold, not caught nearly every child in the city is sick. A model from Shropshire School arrived today. The Cornish sails tomorrow.

Thurs 11th Have just returned from a meeting of the Shropshire Friends Society at Mrs. Fox's. Mr. Fisher called and took me to ride and then left. We at Mrs. Fox's at eight o'clock and called for me again at half past nine. Mrs. Fisher came down with us. I got Lillian's calash before I left and Mrs. Fisher says he has been going. This morn. Mrs. D. Smith called for me and Lillian, Clara, and myself went with her to see Mr. Fisher's shop to see how the new patterns are getting on. We were very much interested in watching the process. Very much. Have been working on Lillian's suit today. Have finished the jacket and skirt. Made all of a pair of pants for Mr. Fisher.

Friday 12th Lillian has been with Clara to see the day at Mrs. Smith's. I have been stitching down on the machine. Have called on Mother David and finished Lillian's suit. Collected the money here been to the Bethel Church meeting with the clerk and Mrs. Black.

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Sat 13th This morn. Lillian and I went to ride with Mrs. Fisher. After we returned I stitched on the machine for Mrs. Fisher until dinner time. After dinner Mrs. Fisher called with her carriage and we again went out to ride.

Sunday 14th This morn. went to the Bethel to S.S. then to the English Church at eleven o'clock to hear Mr. Williamson preach his funeral sermon. This eve. attempted to go out again but Lillian was ill. While I was preparing, and cried with the tooth and ear ache as I could not leave him. He has cried all night.

Monday 15th Lillian kept me awake all night. I did not sleep until after five this morn. He has a very bad cold and I take him very much. Have cut out a white jacket for Mr. Fisher and made the skirt for Lillian. Tonight we went to ride with the American Consul, Mr. Nathan. This eve. have been sitting with Mrs. Fisher and dining. I went down stairs just before dinner.

Tues 16th Have been putting on a white waist for Lillian. This afternoon called on Mrs. Fisher. Mrs. Charles Jones and Mrs. Roberts. Have not been out to ride today.

Wed 17th This is the hundredth anniversary of our marriage. How I wish we were all here. Have passed it together. I have been sewing very hard all day. Tonight after dinner went to ride with Mr. and Mrs. Nathan at half past seven. Went to the prayer meeting at the Bethel. Afterward went with Mr. Fisher to call on Mr. and Mrs. David Smith.
