 has gone Mr Sam Mr Austin and
 family and a number of others from
 the hotel. George Jenkins called to see
 me last eve he is going out in the
 Green Emma. That arrived this morn
 I rec'd a letter from Helen with
 Solus picture and a letter from Paul's
 father.

Friday 7th Have been quite sick for several days but
 feel better tonight. Paul's commenced
 going to school again today.

Saturday 8th Have felt better today so I have sat up
 most of the day and sewed. This eve I
 called on Mrs Perkins, whom we
 are very pleasant people.

Sunday 9th This afternoon went down street to
 give minutes. This eve intended to go
 to prayer meeting but did not feel able.
 Mrs Herbert spent most of the eve in
 my room. Capt Plettin, Madame Dant
 and Mr Clark called.

Monday 10th This afternoon went out to make
 a few calls. This eve Mr Whitman
 and Mr Shattuck called. Mrs Polles
 has invited me to pass summer
 with her Capt Perkins and wife and
 also invited. Edith will stop as he
 comes from school. have been working
 on my new clothes for my self.

Tuesday 11th Have passed the day with Mrs Polles
 Mr & Mrs Pate and Capt & Mrs Perkins and
 Edith and myself were all the winter
 guests present. passed a very pleasant day.
 This eve went to the Bethel Choir meeting.
 The Parade will start at 2 o'clock P.M.
 having completed the necessary repairs.

Wednesday 12th Mr & Mrs Dorem & Capt & Mrs Smith called this eve.
 Have been working on my new clothes
 finished the second pair of drawers
 tonight. The J C Murray arrived today.
 I rec'd a letter from Mrs Mc Henry
 Edith was away about her school.

 been all the time I took him home
 and put him in bed when he has been sick.
