Thursday 5th According to previous arrangement Mrs H. M. Whiting called for me at ten this morning to go to her house to pass the day. Louisa came there from school. We passed a very pleasant day. Returns at seven for Louisa to meet them went to the First Street Church to a Benevolent Society Meeting. Returns at ten. We had a very large and pleasant party. Mrs Robinson Clara Herbert. Mr Whitman went in company with me.

Friday 6th This morning went to the Pali with Capt Egan and daughter. Capt Egan and Mrs Herbert composed the company. Capt Egan Egan and daughter and myself went in the carriage. The others on horseback. Returns home at half past twelve P.M. Mrs Robert Lewis passed the afternoon with me. This eve went to Bethel to rehearsal. Came work with me, after rehearsal Mr Whitman spent to take us home in his carriage he accepted the offer and went out on the trail with a short distance before coming home as the evening was so light and pleasant. I went out and partly made a pair of clothes for Leechie. They
