My all went to see the Physician and I finally consented, and they called in Dr. Haver, who prescribed for me, and his visit and the medicine cost me six and a half dollars but perhaps if I had not had him then I might have been worse and a greater expense so I will be not to worry about it. I am better today although I still feel in considerable pain and very weak.

Sat 15th

This morn rec'd a call from Mr. Williams. Said he should have called before but has been sick. Mrs. McKenzie and Mrs. Rawson called and took Lottie with them to North Beach. Mrs. Ellis and Mrs. Kern called this eve. I am better but still far from being well.

Sund 16th

This morn Mrs. Kern called for me and we with Lottie went to Grace Church on Duckton and Calafornia Sts. to hear Mr. Williamson. His text was Psalm 22nd 1st. I have felt very tired this afternoon but do not think the walk will do me any harm after I get rested. Mrs. Henry Horton & Son and Mrs. Everett Smith and her brother have called this eve. I hear that Mr. Gilbert Allen has arrived but I have not seen him yet.

Mon 20th

Passed the man in my vision of the week Lottie and I went to the Grand Hotel called on Mrs. Owen Mrs. Kern and Mrs. Hickmott. Mrs. Owen went with me to call on Mrs. Welden

and Mrs. McKenzie, the latter was not at home. When I returned found she had called while I was out, also Mr. Gilbert Allen, and Mr. Potter. They

called again in the eve. Tues 21st Mr. Allen called this morn. Said he was sorry they had not let the Panthos go to Honolulu this fall. thinks they will have the ship anchor off Lancelotti as there will not be so much danger of losing the crew. This afternoon called on the Sachin at the Grand Hotel. found only Mrs. Hickmott at home. She went with me to call on Mrs. McKenzie. Mrs. Owen and Mrs. Kern called while I was out.

Wed 24th

Mrs. McKenzie called early this morn and went with me to the Post Office to get two letters that I saw addressed and thought were for me but they proved not to be. She returned and passed the forenoon with me. Mrs. Owen and Mrs. Kern called. This morn and Mrs. Hickmott this afternoon. Mrs. Kern passed the eve with me. Mr. Ellis came about nine accompanying her home. I also rec'd calls this afternoon from Dr. Haver and Dr. Ghalting.

Thurs 25th

This morn rec'd calls from Mr. Potter Mr. Allen and Mrs. Kern. took Lottie and went out for a walk with Mrs. Kern. called at Mrs. McKenzie's this afternoon. Ellen Horton and two children and Harriette Albee, and Mrs. McKenzie have called. Ellen invited me to pass tomorrow at her house, and I have accepted the invitation. Had a letter to Lottie tonight.
