Monday 5th Mrs Owen Mrs McKenzie and Mrs Beattie called early this morn. Mrs Owen was almost crazy with excitement. Mr Ellis sent her word yesterday saying that her husband was coming. afterwards she heard the ship was anchored in the harbor. She sat up all night expecting her husband but he did not come. This morn she heard the ship had arrived but her husband did not come and she knew not what to think. but we told her the ship had not arrived. but had been spoken out long ago all well. so we went home comforted.

Mr Coffey for the third mate acting as second mate until we get to Honolulu in the Spring when we expect to have Mr Barrett for second mate for fourth acting as third. a new steward who is living in his little cabin. also a new cook and boatmen.
