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I have spent the day fackling on
and feel very tired yet sure not half
got through. Expected today fix on bed
we are now use our new Spring Mattress.
We have still some pleasant weather but the
frost being off we will about commence.
Lat 33.40 I have been fackling all day here nearly
finished. Steward came out and with
Lug 12. 25 our boat for supper and went back
to bed. again is not quite recovered
from his drunken frolic. Saw for a
today, hope down to see something better
One of the new boatstainers sent me
two dozen nice Apples Cost 10¢ per
I had a beautiful present from Capt
Whelden of the Line Coast. before leaving
P. E. a Silver Irish Knife with Ring
and Jolly Spoons. George helped him when
they were parted and the Silver did not
he gave us the Silver Spoon

Thurs 21st This morn finished packing away the coats
 & a balance to get cream and butter, Monday
 Sat 32. 13. Two suits for ^{Mr} Middle and cut a women
 Eng 120. 34. Suit for Geo. Have had but little news
 are getting along very slowly. We have very
 pleasant, and good affairs. We have we
 have had this voyage. Stewart, has been up
 part of the day but is hardly able to be
 out yet.

Under 22 The Stomach got up last night about
Eleven o'clock and asked the Capt. saying
Jan 31. 40 he could not sleep and wanted him to
Aug 11. 39 give him some Laudanum George gave him
some but he would not go back to his room he
now drank so half he has the Delirium
Tremens. declared that there was the

 got up and tried to get him to go to his

Dec 23rd Stewart still continues crazy. has not slept
 Leo has been giving him everything he could
 think of but nothing seems to do him any
 good. This morn he came down into the
 Cabin and he was looking for the Steward
 he came down the second time and said
 he wanted the Cell to give him the list of
 names said he changed his name when he
 ran away from home and one of the French
 sailors said the Capt had to let him out
 would let up by saying the reason he came down
 he thought the Capt wanted him to come down
 and take a drink he seems harmless but
 it is impossible to tell what from the disease
