Commenced tailoring this morn I have been working on Muller's suit finished it and knit is on front the parts too large so I have been obliged to rip them in pieces. Shall finish tomorrow.

Sat 8th 9th Have finished tailoring Knicker the whale
 Sat 4th 4th finished up about that are Bells &
 Sun 10th 2nd have finished Muller's suit and done a little mending there is nothing in sight

Monday 10th I have been washing and mending all day have just finished mending

Sat 5th 12th the last of garments. I feel very tired
 Sun 10th 2nd 1/2 have been seen during down the oil
 Mr Price got his boat just repaired back with a cask of oil. There have been a great many fish around the ship here have caught a number have seen two sperm whales, and finbacks and Sulphur bottoms.

Sat 15th Another week has passed marked by no important events we have seen no more whales and not even a sail to sea
 Sat 5th 2nd 1/2 the monotonous. I have made two chemises for myself and a pair of jillie slips and done a little mending this ends another week

Sun 16th Have had several squalls during the day and the weather tonight
 Sat 4th 3rd is not very fair. Saw a brack but by
 Sun 10th 4th and most knowleds it but saw no more think it has a smudge as a large one was seen seen after

Sun 2nd 3rd Another Sabbath has passed we have taken nothing and seen nothing except Albatross Skippers have had fish every day except then an two sails in sight ten or twelve miles

to General Off & Mr Lee with. Think them to be the ship Josephine and back Alaska, but we are not near enough to tell positively. We have been seeing a few but have not seen a whale except a few Shorbacks and Sulphur bottoms during the fortnight I have made one pair of drawers and the most of a nightgown for myself.

Have had very unpleasant weather all the week. have been within more of the ice daily we saw last Sunday. have seen several spots during the week but have found to be Shorbacks or Sulphur bottoms; have seen Blk fish this going towards lower end once but got home I finished my night dress Tuesday. Commenced filling in a Sofa pillow. Dined at dining table but a sort of fish. Cannot tell what occasions it but have had several frosts during the week think perhaps that was the cause. I feel better here but not up but little since dinner

March 5th

Have had a swim down with little but wind we are now on the line. I am better today but not very well, have been at work and Mr Spafford

Sun 4th

This is George's fortieth birthday. and I have nothing to give him for a present but can only give my prayers and best wishes. We are now heading westward on the line. I have nearly finished my winter work. The weather is now with little wind. Nothing in sight

Sat. Oct. 6th
